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# SERVE THE LORD WITH EXCELLENCE AND WITH INTEGRITY

“And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ. But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is no partiality” (Colossians 3:23–25).

[The Bible exhorts us to do everything “heartily, as to the Lord and not to men” \(Colossians 3:23\).](#) The key thought here is to be a people of “Excellence with Integrity”. To attain this standard, we should not be an average worker who does things just to get by or be men pleasers. We have to be “a cut above”, by doing things from the heart and as unto the Lord.

## THE LIGHT AND THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Jesus taught, **“You are the salt of the earth, but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house”** (Matthew 5: 13–16). When you have integrity and excellence in what you do, you are the light and salt of the earth. That means, you are a testimony

of God’s work of salvation in your life. What you do and your life style is appreciated and is a blessing to others. Many will glorify the God of your salvation.

## WHAT IS INTEGRITY?

Integrity is simply moral uprightness. It relates to your character. God is interested in building your character. He wants you to be like Jesus.

### 1. We go the extra mile.

We do willingly, more than what is required, and we do it with the best of our ability and strength.

### 2. We keep our word.

Our yes, is yes and no, is no. When we make pledges or commitments, financial or otherwise, we keep them.

### 3. We give our employers their money’s worth.

There is no cheating and no undercutting. Our bosses can trust us.

### 4. We live with enthusiasm, ever willing to obey, that we may be a witness of God’s grace in our life.

## GOD BLESSES EXCELLENCE WITH INTEGRITY AND NOT MEDIOCRITY.

Job is a wonderful example of a man of excellence with integrity. The Bible describes him as upright and God-fearing, one who shuns evil, and has moral character. Yet, he came under satan’s attack. In Job chapter one, satan claimed that Job lacked integrity and feared God only because God has put a hedge round about him and blessed him. So God allowed Job to be tested by satan who destroyed his children, servants, livestock and home. Next, satan attacked Job physically, covering him with painful sores. But Job kept his integrity and proved himself and God blessed him and gave him back twice as much as he had before (Job 42:10).

The Bible says, **“And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ”** (Colossians 3:23–24). King Solomon said, **“Whatever**

your hand finds to do, do it with all your might; for there is no work or device or knowledge or wisdom in the grave where you are going” (Ecclesiastes 9:10).

### CHOOSE TO BE A WISE MASTER BUILDER

The apostle Paul teaches, “According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But let each one take heed how he builds on it. For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one’s work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one’s work, of what sort it is. If anyone’s work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. If anyone’s work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire. Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?” (1 Corinthians 3:10–16).

Therefore, let us be excellent in what we do and with integrity be wise master builders.

#### The wise master builder will observe the following :

- Jesus Christ is the foundation or the cornerstone, in whatever we build (Ephesians 2:20–22).
- What we build on will either endure or suffer loss when Jesus comes.
- Our works will be tested by fire.
- Be sure of your choice of material (gold, silver, precious stone or hay, wood or stubble).
- There are rewards for the wise master builder.

Jesus in His parable of the talents confirms it to be so. “His lord said to him, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord’” (Matthew 25:21).

### DANGERS TO WATCH

#### A wise master builder serves to please God and not man.

The Bible says, “Bondservants, obey your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God” (Colossians 3:22). We are to build, “Not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart” (Ephesians 6:6). There is integrity when we do it as unto the Lord.

#### A wise master builder serves with the fear of God and not the fear of man.

The greatest need today is the fear of God. The fear of man will make you obey man. Many are made to do wrong or sin because they fear man. Jesus says, “... do not be afraid of those who kill the body. After that, they have no more that they can do. But I will show you whom you should fear. Fear him who after he has killed, has the power to cast you into hell” (Luke 12:4–7). We should not fear man because man’s power is limited. Man can only destroy the body and not the soul. Man can send us out of this world but not out of heaven. Man can separate us from this world but not eternal life. There is no moral integrity in the fear of man.

### WHY FEAR GOD?

1 The Bible teaches, “Are not five sparrows sold for two copper coins? And not one of them is forgotten before God. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows” (Luke 12:6–7). Sparrows are common and

cheap. If God will remember them, He will take care of you. You are of more value to God than many sparrows! King David said, “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom” (Psalms 111:10).

There is God’s providence. The Bible says, “Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? Therefore do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’” (Matthew 6: 30–31).

3

God is all powerful. The Bible says, “With men it is impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible” (Mark 10:27).

4

Our affliction has eternal weight of glory. When you will not compromise, people will be upset with you and this often leads to afflictions. But be encouraged. The Bible says, “For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory” (2 Corinthians 4:17).

5

God’s grace is sufficient. God promised Paul when he cried out to Him regarding his “thorn in the flesh”. God said, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness” (2 Cor 12:9).

At the end of Joshua’s life, he called the Israelites together and recounted how God delivered them from Egypt, led them through the wilderness under Moses’ leadership and blessed and prospered them in the promised land. Joshua warned the Israelites that in the land of prosperity, their neighbours will tempt them to live like heathens. He exhorted them to “...fear the Lord, serve Him in sincerity and in truth”. He also urged them to put away all other gods, and only “serve the Lord” (Joshua 24:14).

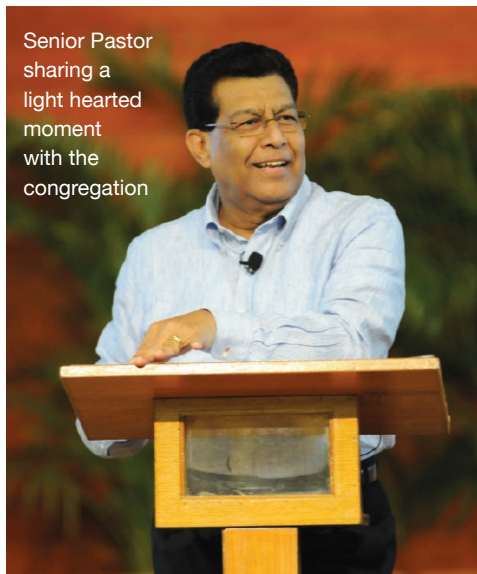

**Kenson Low** — One thing that struck me was that the Holy Spirit does not have a name but He lifts up the name of Jesus! I believe we are called to do the same with all that we have, which are a gift from God.

In the first session, Senior Pastor brought a holistic understanding on the purpose and benefits of spiritual gifts (1 Corinthians 1:12–2:1). Spiritual gifts refer to the supernatural manifestation by the Holy Spirit through believers. They are tools given to us by grace to continue the work of Jesus on earth. The nine gifts in 1 Corinthians 12:7–11 can be divided into 3 classifications viz. revelation gifts, communication gifts and ability gifts. Revelation gifts have to do with the message of wisdom, knowledge and the discernment of spirits.

**Christina Lai** — I am encouraged to discover my latent spiritual gifts and to continue to exercise my existing gifts effectively.

**Augustine Yew** — I recognized that speaking in tongues is a precious spiritual gift from God as it provides self edification, removes any inhibitions and encourages a greater intimacy when communicating with our Lord.

**Joyce Lim** — Senior Pastor's practical demonstration showed me very clearly the difference between interpretation

In the second session, Senior Pastor gave some fresh, helpful insights on communication gifts viz. the gift of tongues, interpretation of tongues and prophecy. To illustrate his teaching on the interpretation of tongues, four individuals from different nationalities read portions of the Scripture in their native language which was later interpreted into English. The light-hearted, practical demonstration drove home the point: a long message in tongues can have a short interpretation and vice-versa!

Session 3 began with a wonderful time of worship where we witnessed the gifts of the Holy Spirit in operation through messages in tongues and words of exhortation given.

Senior Pastor taught on the gifts of ability namely the gift of faith, the gift of healing and the gift of the working of miracles. He stressed that maturity is not based on gifts, but based on the fruits in one's life. The session ended with an apt reminder to pursue love and Christ-likeness above seeking spiritual gifts. ✚

• **Character** — From the account of Jesus' temptation in the wilderness, we were warned that taking shortcuts will never get us where God is leading us as God desires to build our character. # BERKHIDMAT PADA TUHAN DENGAN KECEMERLANGAN DAN DENGAN INTEGRITI

“Dan apa sahaja yang anda lakukan, melakukannya sepenuh hati, untuk Tuhan dan bukan untuk manusia, mengetahui bahawa dari Tuhan anda akan menerima bagian yang ditentukan bagimu sebagai upah kerana anda berkhidmat pada Kristus Tuhan. Tetapi dia yang melakukan salah akan dibalas apa yang telah dilakukan, dan tidak berat sebelah “(Kolose 3:23-25).

Alkitab memerintahkan kita supaya melakukan apa-apa “sepenuh hati, untuk Tuhan dan bukan untuk manusia” (Kolose 3:23). Pemikiran yang utama di sini ialah untuk menjadi orang yang “berkecemerlangan dengan integriti”. Untuk mencapai piawaian ini, kita tidak harus menjadi pekerja yang biasa sahaja, yang melakukan semua perkara dengan sederhana atau hanya untuk memuaskan hati orang lain. Kita perlu menunjukkan kesungguhan lebih daripada orang lain, dengan ikhlas melakukan kerja-kerja seperti ibadah kepada Tuhan.

## CAHAYA DAN GARAM DUNIA

Yesus mengajar, **“Kamu adalah garam dunia. Jika garam itu menjadi tawar, dengan apakah ia diasinkan? Tidak ada lagi gunanya selain dibuang dan diinjak orang. Kamu adalah terang dunia. Kota yang terletak di atas gunung tidak mungkin tersembunyi. Lagi pula orang tidak menyalakan pelita lalu meletakkannya di bawah gantang, melainkan di atas kaki dian sehingga menerangi semua orang di dalam rumah**

**itu. Demikianlah hendaknya terangmu bercahaya di depan orang, supaya mereka melihat perbuatanmu yang baik dan memuliakan Bapamu yang di syurga”**(Matius 5: 13–16). Apabila anda mempunyai integriti dan kecemerlangan dalam apa yang anda lakukan, anda adalah cahaya dan garam dunia. Ini bermakna, anda adalah saksi kepada kerja keselamatan Tuhan dalam kehidupan anda. Apa yang anda lakukan, gaya hidup anda dihargai dan membawa berkat kepada orang lain. Ramai orang akan memuliakan Tuhan keselamatan anda.

## APAKAH INTEGRITI?

Integriti ialah kejujuran bermoral semata-mata. Ia berkaitan dengan keperibadian anda. Tuhan berminat memperkuatkan keperibadian anda. Dia ingin anda menjadi seperti Yesus.

### 1. Kita sanggup melakukan lebih daripada yang diperlukan.

Kita lakukan dengan sukarela, lebih daripada apa yang diperlukan, dan kita melakukannya dengan keupayaan dan kekuatan yang terbaik.

### 2. Kita mengotakan kata-kata kita

Sekira kita kata ya, itulah ya, dan tidak, itulah tidak. Apabila kita membuat perjanjian atau komitmen, kewangan atau sebaliknya, kita mengkotakan kata-kata itu.

### 3. Kita menghasilkan kerja yang setanding dengan nilai upah majikan.

Tidak terdapat penipuan dan perlakuan pintas dalam pekerjaan. Majikan boleh

mempercayai kita.

**4. Kita hidup dengan penuh semangat, sentiasa bersedia untuk mentaati, supaya kita boleh menjadi saksi kepada kasih karunia Tuhan dalam kehidupan kita.**

## TUHAN MEMBERKATI KECEMERLANGAN DENGAN INTEGRITI DAN BUKANNYA KELEKAAN

Ayub adalah contoh yang mengagumkan bagi seorang lelaki yang berkecemerlangan dengan integriti. Alkitab menggambarkan ia seorang yang lurus dan bertaqwa, seorang yang membenci kejahatan, dan mempertahankan akhlak yang baik. Namun demikian ia diserang syaitan. Dalam Ayub bab 1, syaitan mendakwa bahawa Ayub kekurangan integriti dan berasa takut kepada Tuhan kerana Tuhan melindungi dan memberkati nya. Maka Tuhan membenarkan syaitan menguji Ayub dengan memusnahkan anak-anaknya, hamba-hambanya, ternakan dan rumahnya. Seterusnya, syaitan menyerang Ayub secara fizikal, dan menyerang tubuhnya dengan kudis yang menyakitkan. Tetapi Ayub menjaga integritinya dan tetap pendiriannya dan Tuhan memberkatinya dan mengembalikan dua kali ganda kepunyaannya sebelum ini (Ayub 42:10).

Alkitab mengatakan, **“Dan apa sahaja yang anda lakukan, melakukannya sepenuh hati, seperti kepada Tuhan dan bukan kepada manusia, mengetahui bahawa dari Tuhan anda akan menerima bagian yang ditentukan bagimu sebagai upah kerana anda berkhidmat pada Kristus Tuhan”** (Kolose 3:23–24). Raja Sulaiman berkata, **“Segala sesuatu yang dijumpai tanganmu untuk dikerjakan, kerjakanlah itu sekuat tenaga, kerana tak ada pekerjaan, pertimbangan, pengetahuan dan hikmat dalam dunia orang mati, ke mana engkau akan pergi”** (Pengkhotbah 9:10).

## MEMILIH UNTUK MENJADI PAKAR PEMBINA YANG BIJAK

Rasul Paulus mengajar, **“Sesuai dengan kasih karunia Tuhan, yang dianugerahkan kepadaku, aku sebagai seorang ahli bangunan yang cekap telah meletakkan dasar, dan orang lain membangun terus di atasnya. Tetapi tiap-tiap orang harus memperhatikan, bagaimana ia harus membangun di atasnya. Kerana tidak ada seorangpun yang dapat meletakkan dasar lain daripada dasar yang telah**

diletakkan, iaitu Yesus Kristus. Entahkah orang membangun di atas dasar ini dengan emas, perak, batu permata, kayu, rumput kering atau jerami, sekali kelak pekerjaan masing-masing orang akan nampak. Kerana hari Tuhan akan menyatakan, sebab ia akan nampak dengan api dan bagaimana pekerjaan masing-masing orang akan diuji oleh api itu. Jika pekerjaan yang dibangun seseorang tahan uji, ia akan mendapat upah. Jika pekerjaannya terbakar, ia akan menderita kerugian, tetapi ia sendiri akan diselamatkan, tetapi seperti dari dalam api. Tidak tahukah kamu, bahawa kamu adalah bait Tuhan dan bahawa Roh Tuhan diam di dalam kamu?“ (1 Korintus 3:10-16).

Oleh itu, marilah kita menjadi cemerlang dalam apa yang kita lakukan dan dengan integriti menjadi pakar pembina yang arif.

### **Pakar pembina yang arif akan mempertimbang perkara-perkara berikut:**

- Yesus Kristus adalah dasar atau batu penjuru, dalam apa jua yang kita bina (Efesus 2:20-22).
- Apa yang kita bina akan bertahan atau mengalami kerugian apabila Yesus kembali.
- Kerja-kerja kita akan diuji dengan api.
- Pastikan pilihan bahan anda (emas, perak, batu permata atau rumput kering, kayu atau jerami).
- Terdapat ganjaran bagi pakar pembina yang arif.

Yesus dalam perumpamaannya mengenai bakat mengesahkan demikian. **“Maka kata tuannya itu kepadanya: Baik sekali perbuatanmu itu, hai hambaku yang baik dan setia; engkau telah setia dalam perkara kecil, aku akan memberikan kepadamu tanggung jawab dalam perkara yang besar. Masuklah dan turutlah dalam kebahagiaan tuanmu”** (Matius 25:21).

### **BAHAYA-BAHAYA YANG PERLU DIAWASI**

#### **Seseorang pakar pembina yang arif berkhidmat untuk menyenangkan hati Tuhan dan bukan manusia.**

Alkitab berkata, **“Hai hamba-hamba, taatilah tuanmu yang di dunia ini dalam segala hal, jangan hanya di hadapan mereka saja untuk menyenangkan mereka, melainkan dengan tulus hati kerana takut akan Tuhan”** (Kolose 3:22). Kita membina, **“jangan hanya di hadapan**

**mereka saja untuk menyenangkan hati orang, tetapi sebagai hamba-hamba Kristus yang dengan segenap hati melakukan kehendak Tuhan”** (Efesus 6:06). Terdapatlah integriti apabila kita melakukan untuk Tuhan.

#### **Seseorang pakar pembina yang arif berkhidmat dengan ketakutan akan Tuhan dan bukan ketakutan akan manusia.**

Keperluan utama pada masa sekarang ialah ketakutan terhadap Tuhan. Ketakutan akan manusia akan membuat kamu mentaati manusia. Ramai orang melakukan kesalahan atau berdosa kerana mereka takut akan manusia. Yesus berkata, **“... janganlah kamu takut terhadap mereka yang dapat membunuh tubuh dan kemudian tidak dapat berbuat apa-apa lagi. Aku akan menunjukkan kepada kamu siapakah yang harus kamu takuti. Takutilah Dia yang setelah membunuh, mempunyai kuasa untuk melemparkan orang ke dalam neraka.”** (Lukas 12:4-5). Kita tidak harus takut akan manusia kerana kuasa manusia terhad. Manusia hanya boleh memusnahkan badan dan bukan jiwa. Manusia boleh menghantar kita keluar dari dunia ini tetapi bukan dari syurga. Manusia dapat memisahkan kita dari dunia ini tetapi tidak daripada kehidupan yang abadi. Tiada integriti yang bermoral dalam ketakutan terhadap manusia.

### **MENGAPA TAKUT AKAN TUHAN?**

**1** Alkitab mengajar, **“Bukankah burung pipit dijual lima ekor dua duit? Sungguhpun demikian tidak seekorpun daripadanya yang dilupakan Tuhan, bahkan rambut kepalamu pun terhitung semuanya. Kerana itu jangan takut, kerana kamu lebih berharga daripada banyak burung pipit”** (Lukas 12:6-7). Burung pipit adalah biasa dan murah. Jika Tuhan akan mengingat mereka, Dia akan menjaga kamu. Anda adalah lebih bernilai kepada Tuhan daripada banyak burung pipit! Raja Daud berkata, **“Permulaan hikmat adalah takut akan Tuhan”** (Mazmur 111:10).

**2** Terdapat pembekalan Tuhan. Alkitab berkata, **“Jadi jika demikian Tuhan mendandani rumput di ladang, yang hari ini ada dan besok dibuang ke dalam api, tidakkah Ia akan terlebih lagi mendandani kamu, hai orang yang kurang percaya? Sebab itu janganlah**

**kamu kuatir dan berkata: Apakah yang akan kami makan? Apakah yang akan kami minum? Apakah yang akan kami pakai?”** (Matius 6: 30-31).

**3** Tuhan Maha Berkuasa. Alkitab mengatakan, **“Bagi manusia hal itu tidak mungkin, tetapi bukan demikian bagi Tuhan. Sebab segala sesuatu adalah mungkin bagi Tuhan”** (Markus 10:27).

**4** Penderitaan kita mempunyai kemuliaan yang kekal.

Apabila anda tidak bertolak ansur, orang lain akan berasa kecewa dengan anda dan ini sering membawa penderitaan. Tetapi jangan putus asa. Alkitab berkata, **“Sebab penderitaan ringan yang sekarang ini, mengerjakan bagi kami kemuliaan kekal yang melebihi segala-segalanya, jauh lebih besar daripada penderitaan kami”** (2 Korintus 4:17).

# 以卓越和诚信的心事奉主

文：古纳南主任牧师

“无论做什么，都要从心里做，像是给主做的，不是给人做的，因你们知道从主那里必得着基业为赏赐。你们所事奉的乃是主基督。那行不义的，必受不义的报应；主并不偏待人”（西3:23-25）。

圣经劝勉我们做每一件事“都要从心里做，像是给主做的，不是给人做的”（西3:23）。这里的关键思想是要作“卓越和诚信”的人。为了要达到这个标准，我们不应该是一个一般的工人，工作只是为了过活或取悦于人。我们一定要“高于一般的程度”，要从心里做和像是给主做的。

## 世上的光与盐

耶稣教导说，“你们是世上的盐。盐若失了味，怎能叫它再咸呢？以后无用，不过丢在外面，被人践踏了。你们是世上的光。城造在山上，是不能隐藏的。人点灯，不放在斗底下，是放在灯台上，就照亮一家的人。你们的光也当这样照在人前，叫他们看见你们的好行为，便将荣耀归给你们在天上的父”（太5:13-16）。当你做事是有卓越和诚信的话，你就是世上的光和盐。这意味着，你是神在你生命中的救恩工作的见证。你所做的和你的生活方式被赞赏并且是他人的祝福。许多人会将荣耀归给你救恩的神。

## 什么是诚信？

诚信就是正直的道德。它涉及到你的性格。神关注建立你的性格。他希望你能像耶稣。

1. 我们多走一里路。

我们愿意做，比所需要的更多，并且我们尽我们最好的能力和力量去做。

2. 我们信守诺言。

我们说是就是，说不是就不是。当我们在财务上或其他方面作出承诺或委身时，我们要信守承诺。

3. 我们为我们的雇主，提供与工资等值的工作表现。

没有欺骗和削价与竞争者抢生意。我们的老

板可以信任我们。

4. 我们热心地生活，总是愿意顺服，使到我们可以成为神在我们生命里的恩典的见证人。

## 上帝祝福卓越和诚信的人，而不是平庸的人。

约伯是一个很好的例子，他是一个卓越与诚信的人。圣经描述他为人正直和敬畏上帝，远离恶事，并且有品德。然而，他受到撒旦的攻击。在约伯记第一章，撒旦声称，约伯缺乏诚信和敬畏神是因为神在四面圈上篱笆围护他和赐福予他。所以上帝允许撒旦试验约伯，杀害他的孩子，仆人，牲畜和摧毁他的家。下一步，撒旦攻击约伯的身体，使他从脚掌到头顶长满毒疮。但是约伯保持他的诚信并证明了他自己和上帝祝福他，并赐给他的比从前所有的加倍（伯42:10）。

圣经说，“无论做什么，都要从心里做，像是给主做的，不是给人做的，因你们知道从主那里必得着基业为赏赐；你们所事奉的乃是主基督。”（西3:23-24）。所罗门王说：“凡你手所当做的事，要尽力去做，因为在你所必去的阴间，没有工作，没有谋算，没有知识，也没有智慧”（传9:10）。

## 选择做一个聪明的工头

使徒保罗教导说，“我照神所给我的恩赐，好像一个聪明的工头，立好了根基，有别人在上面建造，只是各人要谨慎怎样在上面建造。因为那已经立好的根基就是耶稣基督，此外没有人能立别的根基。若有人用金、银、宝石、草木、禾秸在这根基上建造，各人的工程必然显露，因为那日子要将它表明出来，有火发现，这火要试验各人的工程怎样。人在那根基上所建造的工程若存得住，他就要得赏赐；人的工程若被烧了，他就要受亏损，自己却要得救；虽然得救，乃像从火里经过的一样。岂不知你们是神的殿，神的灵住在你们里头吗？”（林前3:10-16）

因此，让我们所做的都是以卓越和诚信的心去做，做一个聪明的工头

一个聪明的工头会遵守以下所说：

- 无论我们建造什么，耶稣基督是根基或房角石（弗2:20-22）。
- 当耶稣再来时，我们在根基上建造的工程将保存得住或遭受损毁。
- 我们的工程将被火试验。
- 要确保你选择的材料（金，银，宝石或草木、禾秸）。
- 聪明的工头就要得赏赐。

耶稣在他按才干分银子的比喻里证实这点。“主人说：‘好！你这又良善又忠心的仆人，你在不多的事上有忠心，我要把许多事派你管理；可以进来享受你主人的快乐。’”（太25:21）

## 要提防的危险

一个聪明的工头的事奉是为了讨神的喜悦，而不是讨人的喜悦。

圣经说：“你们作仆人的，要凡事听从你们肉身的主人，不要只在眼前事奉，像是讨人喜欢的，总要存心诚实敬畏主”（西3:22）。我们的建造，“不要只在眼前事奉，像是讨人喜欢的，要像基督的仆人，从心里遵行神的旨意”（弗6:6）。当我们这样做像是给主做时，就有诚信。

一个聪明的工头是以敬畏神的心，而不是害怕人的心事奉。

今天最需要的是对神的敬畏。害怕人的将使你服从人。许多人犯错或犯罪，因为他们害怕人。耶稣说：“...那杀身体以后不能再做什么的，不要怕他们。我要指示你们当怕的是谁，当怕那杀了以后又有权柄丢在地狱里的”（路12:4-7）。我们不应该害怕人，因为人的权柄是有限的。人只能破坏身体，而不是灵魂。人可以使我们离开这个世界，但不能使我们离开天堂。人可以把我和这个世界分开，但不能把我和永生分开。害怕人的没有道德诚信。

## 为什么要敬畏神？

1 圣经教导说，“五个麻雀不是卖二分银子吗？但在神面前，一个也不忘记；就是你们的头发，也都被数过了。不要惧怕，你们比许多麻雀还贵重！”（路12:6-7）。麻雀是常见和廉价的。如果神会纪念他们，他必会眷顾你。对神来说你比许多麻雀还贵重！大卫王说，“敬畏耶和华是智慧的开端”（诗篇111:10）。

2 有上帝的护理。

圣经说，“你们这小信的人哪！野地里的草今天还在，明天就丢在炉里，神还给它这样的妆饰，何况你们呢！所以，不要忧虑说：‘吃什么？喝什么？穿什么？’”

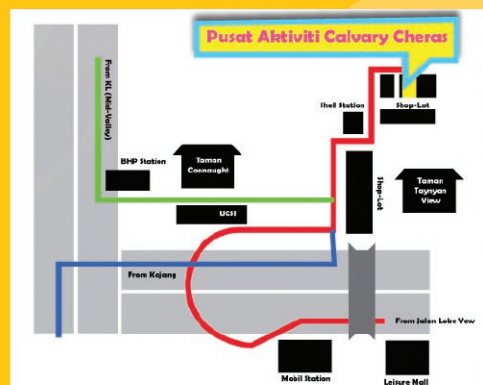
