God's will is that you prosper. The biblical understanding of prosperity is godly contentment (1 Tim 6:6). He gives us power to get wealth to fulfil His covenant or promises (Deut 8:18). Doing God's will and fulfilling God's vision for your life and the Church means we need to prosper. The way to prosper is to give. The Bible teaches us to give to receive.

What Is Giving?

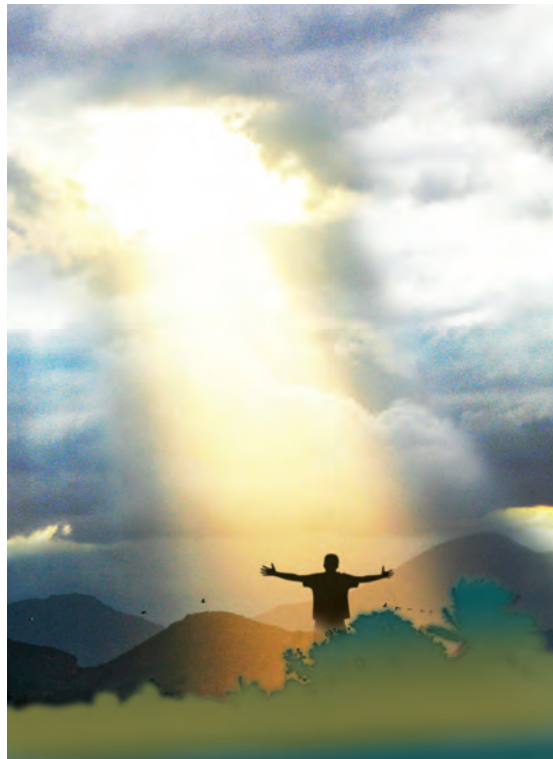
- Giving is not paying for one's work done. Your salary is not a gift because you earned it.
- Giving is without condition. It is free from obligations and control.
- Giving is not a loan which you have to pay back.
- Giving is based on what you have.

Giving Is An Attitude.

We are to give willingly and cheerfully. The Bible says, "*Take from among you an offering to the LORD. Whoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it as an offering to the LORD: gold, silver, and bronze ...*" (Exod 35:5). God loves a cheerful giver. "*So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver*" (2 Cor 9:7).

Whenever you have an opportunity to give an offering or make a pledge, do it willingly, not grudgingly or of necessity. Give in obedience because the Bible tells us to be givers.

The triune God, God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are givers.



God gives us salvation.

He died for us while we were yet sinners. The Bible says, "*For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God*" (Eph 2:8). *Faith is a gift from God* (Romans 12:3). He gives us all we need to live, and to be godly. "*His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue*" (2 Peter 1:3).

Jesus is the giver of abundant life.

The Bible says, "*Jesus have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly*" (John 10:10). And, "*For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich*" (2 Cor 8:9).

The Holy Spirit is the giver of spiritual gifts and a Helper.

The Bible says, "*Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered*" (Romans 8:26). 1 Corinthians 12:4-10 lists the diverse spiritual gifts that the Holy Spirit gives to us.

There are six Biblical principles to live under God's open windows of heaven.

1. Be A Giver

The Bible says, "*Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you*" (Luke 6:38). It is through giving or sowing that you receive and reap a harvest. When we give to God, He gives us in abundance. Scriptures says, it will be given to you, "running over into your bosom".

Offerings are your expression of worship. The wisemen gave to Jesus. The Bible says, "*When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceedingly great joy. And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshiped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankincense, and myrrh*" (Matthew 2:10-11). And "*Honor the LORD with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase; so your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine*" (Proverbs 3:9-10).

Tithes are your submission to His Lordship as faithful stewards.

The Bible says, *“And the Lord said, ‘Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his master will make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of food in due season? Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes’”* (Luke 12:42-43).

When you fail in giving your offerings and tithes, you rob God of worship and Lordship due to Him. *“Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, ‘In what way have we robbed You? In tithes and offerings. You are cursed with a curse, for you have robbed Me, even this whole nation’”* (Malachi 3:8-9).

2. Right Priorities

The Bible says, *“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you”* (Matthew 6:33). Let God have the first priority in everything you have, your time, giftings and energy.

This means we ought to have the right mindset.

Set your mind on things that glorify God. The Bible says, *“If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth”* (Col 3:1-2).

And we must not be double minded. *“But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways”* (James 1:6-8).

3. Do Not Fear

The Bible says, *“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind”* (2 Timothy 1:7). And Job said, *“For the thing I greatly feared has come upon me, and what I dreaded has happened to me”* (Job 3:25).

Fear is a bondage that keeps you from receiving what God has for you. You become a prisoner, kept from all that God has promised you! When we don't have

faith, we are reluctant to give, for we fear for the future. Do not let fear to rule your heart and mind. People with faith know how to give.

We should not fear because God makes good all His promises. The Bible says, *“God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?”* (Num 23:19). And *“For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us”* (2 Cor 1:20).

4. Have Faith

Fear and faith are not friends but enemies. Fear walks out when faith comes in. God has given each of us a measure of faith that was taken from us because of sin. Our sins are forgiven and you have received faith. *“For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith”* (Romans 2:3).

The raising of Lazarus

Jesus told the two sisters of Lazarus that he will live. They believed, thinking he would be raised on the Lord's day. But Jesus said, *“‘Take away the stone.’ But Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, ‘Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been four days.’ Jesus said to her, ‘Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?’”* (John 11:39-40). Believe in Jesus. Rebuke your fear and see the glory of God, no matter what your challenges may be.

Faith is a Rewarder

The Bible says, *“But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him”* (Hebrews 11:6). We are exhorted not to *“... become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises”* (Hebrews 6:12).

- Be at peace when you obey in faith. Jesus said, *“Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world*

gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid” (John 14:1 & 27).

When there is no fear, there's faith. Do not give in to fear.

5. Keep Your Promises

God keeps His promises. The Bible says, *“So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it”* (Isaiah 55:11), and *“God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?”* (Numbers 23:19).

Like Father, like Son

We must keep our promises and our commitments just like God keeps His. The Bible says, *“When you make a vow to the LORD your God, you shall not delay to pay it; for the LORD your God will surely require it of you, and it would be sin to you. That which has gone from your lips you shall keep and perform, for you voluntarily vowed to the LORD your God what you have promised with your mouth”* (Deut 23:21;23). *“Offer to God thanksgiving, and pay your vows to the Most High. Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me”* (Psalm 50:14-15).

6. Speak What The Bible Says

Watch what you speak. The Bible says, *“There is one who speaks like the piercings of a sword, but the tongue of the wise promotes health”* (Proverbs 12:18). And *“Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit”* (Prov 18:21). What we say will condemn us. So speak life and speak positive and good things that will edify and build each other up.

As you practice the principles to live under God's open windows of heaven, you will experience God's blessings of prosperity. God desires to bless you so you can be the channel for His blessings to touch lives for His kingdom. You can do the will of God and see God's vision in your life fulfilled! We are a people with a destiny.

HONOURING GOD WITH OUR GIVING

What a wonderful testimony of giving of her family to serve God.

"It is mind boggling what God has done for your church. CCC is not the result of

man's vision or ingenuity. It is the result of God's vision that was birthed in your Senior Pastor!" declared Sister Seaward as she began her message. Her anointed preaching was an inspiring challenge.

She challenged us to give sacrificially. Sacrificial giving involves pain. But the encouragement is that there is no sacrifice greater than God's sacrifice of His one and only Son (John 3:16). Jesus laid down His life, His all that we might be saved. We cannot separate love from giving. The more you love, the more you will give.

The Bible says the Lord spoke to Moses to take an offering from the Israelites (Exodus 25:1) for the building of a tabernacle where He can dwell and His people can meet with Him. The offering was initiated by God. The building of CCC is for God's glory. Giving to CCC is not giving to a building but giving to God!

We were encouraged to trust (depend on) the Lord with all of our hearts, to acknowledge Him as Lord

and Master of our finances and to honour Him in our giving (Prov 3:5-6). Trusting the Lord entails trusting His Word, His Wisdom and His Ways. We are not to lean on our own understanding but to have a spiritual perspective on giving.

Sister Seaward also highlighted many biblical promises on giving, sowing and reaping, illustrating them with powerful testimonies how God blessed her and others who gave sacrificially in obedience to His promptings. At their times of need, God would

supernaturally bless them financially and in many other ways, through unexpected people whom He spoke to. Praise God that we cannot out-give Him and we reap what we sow!

The Bible says, "... He who sows bountifully shall reap also bountifully" (2 Cor 9:6). In Greek, bountifully means to eulogise, commend or honour. Sowing bountifully is honouring, worshipping and blessing God!

After the message, Senior Pastor Prince Guneratnam thanked God for this wonderful privilege to give to Him and partner with Him to experience Him like never before. He prayed that as we give

“How to be a good father?”

asked Senior Pastor Prince Guneratnam at the Father's Day Breakfast held on the 14 June 2014 at the CCC Multi-Purpose Hall.

This is the heart cry of every responsible father. The world throws at us many different models of parenting. Our own fathers affect our perception of fatherhood. And some grow up without a father. Thank God we do not follow the way of the world as we have a model of the perfect father in our Heavenly Father.

Without a doubt, the 110 participants were blessed in many ways. To begin with, there was a scrumptious breakfast served by the ladies from Dimensions and the church staff. This also provided a time for the participants to fellowship and to get to know one another.

After breakfast, Suresh Raman led us in a song of worship followed by Senior Pastor Prince Guneratnam's sharing.

Senior Pastor laid the foundation by emphasizing that God is our perfect Father and thus, the perfect model for fatherhood. To be a godly father, it is important that we know God better by reading the Word of God. Fathers were reminded that they are to fulfil their responsibilities as follows:

- To be the head of the family;
- To be the bearer of God's blessings;
- To be respected for his authority;
- To be the priest and teacher of the family; and
- To be a provider and protector of his family.

Senior Pastor shared that in every child there is a man. We must develop that man in every child. Similarly there is a father in every man. We must develop that Fatherhood. The Holy Spirit will help us.

Then we had our small groups discussion and the moderator, Samuel Kurian encouraged us to brainstorm on raising questions on fathering. These questions were then presented to the panellists, comprising Rev. Fred Seaward, Rev. Margaret Seaward, Senior Pastor, Senior Associate Pastor Petrina Guneratnam, Pam Lee, Chin Ki Fen, Puan Chen Keck, and Wong Horr Wai.

Below are some excerpts of the Q & A session:

- “How does technology, such as smart phones and iPad, affect the father and child relationship?”

Horr Wai, a father of two young girls, shared that it is important that in restricting our children on the use of such gadgets, we must replace them by spending time with our children – in recreation, reading or activities. Also, parents need to be a good example by not using these gadgets when they are with their children. Pastor Fred warned



the fathers to be aware of the video games that children are playing as many are violent and even demonic in nature.

- *“Should we correct the child with a soft or hard tone?”*
Pam, a counsellor and mother of three, said that of course a soft tone is preferable. But what is more important is that correction is done in love and not in the heat of anger.
- *“What should a father do if he finds it difficult to apologize to his children when he has done wrong, e.g. losing temper?”*
Puan shared that if we know how to apologize to other adults when we have done wrong, all the more we should apologize to our children when we have done them wrong. In short, we must overcome our pride and ego.
- *“In today’s world, the wife can earn more than the husband. What if because of her higher income, she starts calling the shots at home?”*
Sister Petrina answered that regardless of how much the wife makes, the Bible

is clear that the man (father) is the head of the household and the wife must submit to that. Pam added that if we allow the wife to be the head of the home by virtue of her higher income, then we are teaching our children that the value of a person is monetary – which is not what we want!

For over an hour, the participants were absorbed in the practical Q&A session. Then, Samuel opened up to the floor to share their experiences on fatherhood. Phan, said, “Being a father is a continual learning process which is much more complex than a professional job.”

Philip testified that before becoming a Christian, he often compared himself with his earthly father to check if he was doing right in fathering. But since he was saved, he has learnt that there is a perfect model of fatherhood in God, the Father. Benny shared that being a father has helped him understand and identify with the father-heart of God.

The last question addressed was, “How do we be good fathers since we are so busy these days?” The rule, stressed

Senior Pastor, is to determine your priorities. Your first priority is always God, followed by your family, after which, comes all the rest. If you follow this, you won’t go wrong.

In conclusion, Senior Pastor shared four invaluable tips with fathers:

- A dad is respected because he gives his children leadership;
- A dad is appreciated because he gives his children care;
- A dad is valued because he gives his children time;
- A dad is loved because he gives his children one thing they treasure most – himself.

Praise and thank God for an enjoyable and beneficial time. There was fostering of friendship and support among the men and fathers and they left wiser and inspired to be godly fathers and role models.

interesting anecdotes, from being a boss to being a mother.

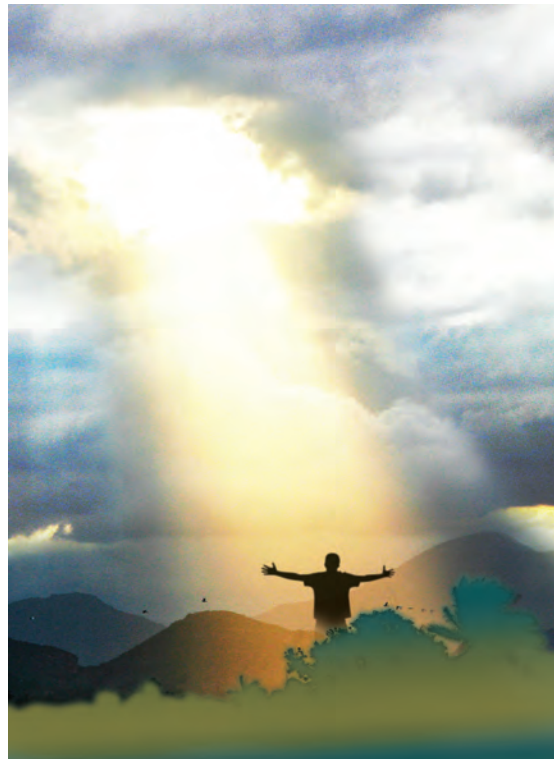
Apakah itu Pemberian?

- Pemberian adalah berasaskan apa yang kamu ada.

Pemberian Adalah Satu Sikap.

Kita harus memberi dengan rela dan dengan sukacita. Alkitab berkata, “*Ambillah bagi Tuhan persembahan khusus dari barang kepunyaanmu; setiap orang yang terdorong hatinya harus membawanya sebagai persembahan khusus kepada Tuhan : emas, perak, tembaga...*” (Keluaran 35:5). Tuhan mengasihi pemberi yang memberi dengan sukacita. “*Hendaklah masing-masing memberikan menurut kerelaan hatinya, jangan dengan sedih hati atau karena paksaan, sebab Tuhan mengasihi orang yang memberi dengan sukacita*” (2 Korintus 9:7).

Apabila kamu ada peluang untuk memberi persembahan atau membuat janji pemberian, lakukannyalah secara rela, bukan dengan rasa seperti dipaksa atau pun memikirkan bahawa ianya adalah satu keperluan untuk memberi. Beri dengan taat kerana Alkitab memberitahu kita untuk menjadi pemberi.



Tuhan Tritunggal, Tuhan Bapa, Anak dan Roh Kudus adalah pemberi.

Tuhan memberikan kita keselamatan.

Ia mati untuk kita di saat kita masih berdosa. Alkitab mengatakan, “*Sebab karena kasih karunia kamu diselamatkan oleh iman; itu bukan hasil usahamu, tetapi pemberian Tuhan*” (Efe 2:8). *Iman adalah satu anugerah daripada Tuhan* (Roma 12:3). Ia memberikan kita semua yang kita perlukan untuk kehidupan, dan untuk menjadi saleh. “*Karena kuasa ilahi-Nya telah menganugerahkan kepada kita segala sesuatu yang berguna untuk hidup yang saleh oleh pengenalan kita akan Dia, yang telah memanggil kita oleh kuasa-Nya yang mulia dan ajaib*” (2 Petrus 1:3).

Yesus adalah pemberi kehidupan yang berkelimpahan.

Alkitab mengatakan, “*Pencuri datang hanya untuk mencuri dan membunuh dan membinasakan; Aku datang, supaya mereka mempunyai hidup, dan mempunyainya dalam segala kelimpahan*” (Yohanes 10:10). Dan, “*Karena kamu telah mengenal kasih karunia Tuhan kita Yesus Kristus, bahwa Ia,*

yang oleh karena kamu menjadi miskin, sekalipun Ia kaya, supaya kamu menjadi kaya oleh karena kemiskinan-Nya” (2 Kor 8:9).

Roh Kudus adalah pemberi karunia rohani dan juga seorang Penolong. Alkitab mengatakan, “*Demikian juga Roh membantu kita dalam kelemahan kita; sebab kita tidak tahu, bagaimana sebenarnya harus berdoa; tetapi Roh sendiri berdoa untuk kita kepada Tuhan dengan keluhan-keluhan yang tidak terucap*” (Roma 8:26). 1 Korintus 12:4-10 menyenaraikan pelbagai anugerah Roh Kudus.

Ada enam prinsip Alkitabiah untuk hidup di bawah tingkap Syurga Tuhan yang terbuka.

1. Jadilah seorang Pemberi

Alkitab mengatakan, “*Berilah dan kamu akan diberi: suatu takaran yang baik, yang dipadatkan, yang digoncang dan yang tumpah ke luar akan dicurahkan ke dalam ribaanmu. Sebab ukuran yang kamu pakai untuk mengukur, akan diukurkan kepadamu*” (Lukas 6:38). Melalui pemberianlah atau penanaman kamu akan menerima dan menuai satu tuaian. Apabila kita memberi kepada Tuhan, Ia memberi kita balik dengan berkelimpahan. Alkitab mengatakan, kamu akan diberi, “akan dicurahkan ke dalam ribaanmu.”

Pemberian menunjukkan penyembahanmu. Alkitab mengatakan, “*Ketika mereka melihat bintang itu, sangat bersukacitalah mereka. Maka masuklah mereka ke dalam rumah itu dan melihat Anak itu bersama Maria, ibu-Nya, lalu sujud menyembah Dia. Merekapun membuka tempat harta bendanya dan mempersembahkan persembahan kepada-Nya, yaitu emas, kemenyan dan mur*” (Matius 2:10-11). Dan, “*Muliakanlah TUHAN dengan hartamu dan dengan hasil pertama dari segala penghasilanmu, maka lumbung-lumbungmu akan diisi penuh sampai melimpah-limpah, dan bejana pemerahanmu akan meluap dengan air buah anggurnya*” (Amsal 3:9-10).

Pemberian persepuluhan adalah penyerahan kamu kepada ketuanannya sebagai pengurus yang setia.

Alkitab mengatakan, *“Jawab Tuhan: ‘Jadi, siapakah pengurus rumah yang setia dan bijaksana yang akan diangkat oleh tuannya menjadi kepala atas semua hambanya untuk memberikan makanan kepada mereka pada waktunya? Berbahagialah hamba, yang didapati tuannya melakukan tugasnya itu, ketika tuannya itu datang”* (Lukas 12:42-43).

Apabila kamu gagal memberi pemberian dan persepuluhan kamu, kamu mencuri dari Tuhan dan tidak tunduk kepada ketuanannya. Dan *“Bolehkah manusia menipu Tuhan? Namun kamu menipu Aku. Tetapi kamu berkata: ‘Dengan cara bagaimanakah kami menipu Engkau?’ Mengenai persembahan persepuluhan dan persembahan khusus! Kamu telah kena kutuk, tetapi kamu masih menipu Aku, ya kamu seluruh bangsa!”* (Maleakhi 3:8-9).

2. Keutamaan Yang Betul

Alkitab mengatakan, *“Tetapi carilah dahulu Kerajaan Tuhan dan kebenarannya, maka semuanya itu akan ditambahkan kepadamu”* (Matius 6:33). Biar Tuhan memiliki keutamaan dahulu dalam segala yang kamu miliki, masa kamu, anugerah kamu dan tenaga kamu.

Ini bermakna kita harus memiliki pemikiran yang betul. Tetapkan pemikiran kamu atas perkara-perkara yang memuliakan Tuhan. Alkitab mengatakan, *“Karena itu, kalau kamu dibangkitkan bersama dengan Kristus, carilah perkara yang di atas, di mana Kristus ada, duduk di sebelah kanan Tuhan. Pikirkanlah perkara yang di atas, bukan yang di bumi”* (Kol 3: 1-2). Dan kita tidak harus mempunyai dua hati. *“Hendaklah ia memintanya dalam iman, dan sama sekali jangan bimbang, sebab orang yang bimbang sama dengan gelombang laut, yang diombang-ambingkan kian ke mari oleh angin. Orang yang demikian janganlah mengira, bahwa ia akan menerima sesuatu dari Tuhan. Sebab orang yang mendua hati tidak akan tenang dalam hidupnya”* (Yakobus 1:6-8).

3. Jangan Takut

Alkitab mengatakan, *“Sebab Tuhan memberikan kepada kita bukan roh ketakutan, melainkan roh yang membangkitkan kekuatan, kasih dan ketertiban”* (2 Timotius 1:7). Dan Ayub berkata *“Karena yang kutakutkan, itulah yang menimpa aku, dan yang kucemaskan, itulah yang mendatangi aku”* (Ayub 3:25).

Ketakutan adalah satu belenggu yang menghalang kamu daripada menerima daripada apa yang Tuhan mahu beri pada kamu! Kamu menjadi tawanan, dihalang dari semua yang Tuhan janjikan pada kamu.

Apabila kita tidak miliki iman, kita enggan memberi, kerana kita takutkan masa depan. Jangan biarkan ketakutan menguasai hati dan pemikiran kamu. Orang yang beriman tahu bagaimana untuk memberi.

Kita tidak harus takut kerana Tuhan menepati semua janjiNya. Alkitab mengatakan, *“Tuhan bukanlah manusia, sehingga Ia berdusta bukan anak manusia, sehingga Ia menyesal. Masakan Ia berfirman dan tidak melakukannya, atau berbicara dan tidak menepatinya?”* (Bil 23:19). Dan *“Sebab Kristus adalah ‘ya’ bagi semua janji Tuhan. Itulah sebabnya oleh Dia kita mengatakan ‘Amin’ untuk memuliakan Tuhan”* (2 Kor 1:20).

4. Miliki Iman

Ketakutan dan iman bukanlah kawan tetapi adalah musuh. Ketakutan keluar apabila iman masuk. Tuhan telah memberikan setiap daripada kita satu ukuran iman yang telah diambil daripada kita oleh kerana dosa. Dosa kita telah diampuni dan kamu telah menerima iman. *“Dan engkau, hai manusia, engkau yang menghakimi mereka yang berbuat demikian, sedangkan engkau sendiri melakukannya juga, adakah engkau sangka, bahwa engkau akan luput dari hukuman Tuhan?”* (Roma 2:3).

Kebangkitan Lazarus

Yesus memberitahukan kepada dua adik perempuan Lazarus bahawa Lazarus akan hidup. Mereka percaya, memikirkan bahawa ia akan dibangkitkan pada Hari Tuhan. Tetapi kata Yesus: *“Angkat batu itu!”* Marta, saudara orang yang meninggal itu, berkata kepada-Nya: *“Tuhan, ia sudah berbau, sebab sudah empat hari ia mati. Jawab Yesus: ‘Bukankah sudah Kukatakan kepadamu: Jikalau engkau percaya engkau akan melihat kemuliaan Tuhan?’* (Yohanes 11:39-40). Percaya kepada Yesus. Herdiklah ketakutan dan lihat kemuliaan Tuhan, tidak kira apa cabarannya.

Iman adalah satu Ganjaran.

Alkitab mengatakan, *“Tetapi tanpa iman tidak mungkin orang berkenan kepada Tuhan. Sebab barangsiapa berpaling kepada Tuhan, ia harus percaya bahwa Tuhan ada, dan bahwa Tuhan memberi upah kepada orang yang sungguh-sungguh mencari Dia”* (Ibrani 11:6). Kita digalakkan *“...agar kamu jangan menjadi lamban, tetapi menjadi penurut-penurut mereka yang oleh iman dan kesabaran mendapat bagian dalam apa yang dijanjikan Tuhan”* (Ibrani 11:12).

- Adanya damai apabila kamu mentaati dengan iman.

Alkitab mengatakan *“Janganlah gelisah hatimu; percayalah kepada Tuhan, percayalah juga kepada-Ku. Damai sejahtera Kutinggalkan bagimu. Damai sejahtera-Ku Kuberikan kepadamu, dan apa yang Kuberikan tidak seperti yang*

diberikan oleh dunia kepadamu. Janganlah gelisah dan gentar hatimu” (Yohanes 14:1 & 27).

Apabila tidak ada ketakutan, akan ada iman. Jangan benarkan ketakutan wujud.

5. Tepatilah Janji Kamu

Tuhan menepati janjiNya. Alkitab mengatakan, *“demikianlah firman-Ku yang keluar dari mulut-Ku: ia tidak akan kembali kepada-Ku dengan sia-sia, tetapi ia akan melaksanakan apa yang Kukehendaki, dan akan berhasil dalam apa yang Kusuruhkan kepadanya”* (Yesaya 55:11) dan *“Tuhan bukanlah manusia, sehingga Ia berdusta bukan anak manusia, sehingga Ia menyesal. Masakan Ia berfirman dan tidak melakukannya, atau berbicara dan tidak menepatinya?”* (Bilangan 23:19).

Seperti Bapa, seperti Anak

Kita mesti menepati kata-kata kita dan janji kita seperti Tuhan menepati kata-kata dan janjiNya. Alkitab berkata, *“Apabila engkau bernazar kepada TUHAN, Tuhanmu, janganlah engkau menunda-nunda memenuhinya, sebab tentulah TUHAN, Tuhanmu, akan menuntutnya dari padamu, sehingga hal itu menjadi dosa bagimu”* (Ulangan 23:21,23). *“Apa yang keluar dari bibirmu haruslah kaulakukan dengan setia, sebab dengan sukarela kaunazarkan kepada TUHAN, Tuhanmu, sesuatu yang kaukatakan dengan mulutmu sendiri.”* *“Persembahkanlah syukur sebagai korban kepada Tuhan dan bayarlah nazarmu kepada Yang Mahatinggi! Berserulah kepada-Ku pada waktu kesesakan, Aku akan meluputkan engkau, dan engkau akan memuliakan Aku”* (Mazmur 50:14-15).

6. Ucapkanlah Apa Yang Dikatakan Dalam Alkitab

Berjaga-jaga dengan apa yang kamu ucapkan. Alkitab berkata, *“Ada orang yang lancang mulutnya seperti tikaman pedang, tetapi lidah orang bijak mendatangkan kesembuhan”* (Amsal 12:18). Dan *“Hidup dan mati dikuasai lidah, siapa suka menggemakannya, akan memakan buahnya”* (Amsal 18:21). Apa yang kita katakan boleh mengutuk kita. Jadi ucapkanlah perkara-perkara yang membawa kehidupan dan bercakap positif dan perkara-perkara baik yang mengajar dan membina satu sama lain.

Apabila kamu mempraktikkan prinsip-prinsip untuk hidup dibawah tingkap syurga Tuhan yang terbuka, kamu akan mengalami berkat Tuhan. Tuhan ingin memberkati kamu agar kamu boleh menjadi saluran untuk berkatNya untuk menjamah jiwa-jiwa untuk kerajaanNya. Kamu boleh melakukan kehendak Tuhan dan melihat visi Tuhan dalam kehidupan kamu dipenuhi! Kita adalah umat yang memiliki takdir Tuhan.

的旨意是要你兴盛。圣经对兴盛的理解是敬虔加上知足的心(提前6:6)。祂给了我们，得货财的力量，为要坚定祂所立的约或应许(申8:18)。遵行神的旨意和完成神对你的生命和教会的异象意味着我们需要兴盛。兴盛的方法就是要施予。圣经教导我们要为收受而施予。什么是施予？

- 施予不是支付完成的工作。你的薪水不是一个礼物，因为这是你赚取的。
- 施予是无条件的——它是不受控制和没有义务的。
- 施予不是贷款，贷款是你必须偿还的。
- 施予是根据你有的。

施予是一种态度

我们要甘心 and 乐意的施予。圣经上说：「你们中间要拿礼物献给耶和華，凡乐意献的，可以拿耶和華的礼物来，就是金，银，铜…」(出35:5)。神喜爱捐得乐意的人。「各人要随本心所酌定的，不要作难，不要勉强，因为捐得乐意的人是神所喜爱的」(林后9:7)。无论何时你有机会奉献或作捐助承诺，乐意地去做，不要作难，不要勉强。顺服地给予因为圣经告诉我们要作奉献者。

三位一体的神，圣父，圣子和圣灵都是赐予者

神赐予我们救恩

唯有祂在我们还做罪人的时候为我们死。圣经上说：「你们得救是本乎恩，也因着信。这并不是出于自己，乃是神所赐的」(弗2:8)。信心是神赐的礼物(罗12:3)。神赐给一切属于生命和虔敬的事。「神的神能已将一切关乎生命和虔敬的事赐给我们，皆因我们认识那用自己荣耀和美德召我们的主」(彼后1:3)。

耶稣是丰盛的生命赐予者

圣经上说：「我来了，是要叫羊得生命，并且得的更丰盛」(约10:10)。「你们知道我们主耶稣基督的恩典：祂本来富足，却为你们成了贫穷，叫你们因祂的贫穷可以成为富足」(林后8:9)。

圣灵是属灵的恩赐的赐予者和帮助者

圣经上说：「况且，我们的软弱有圣灵帮助。我们本不晓得当怎样祷告，只是圣灵亲自用说不出来的叹息替我们祷告」(罗8:26)。林前12:4-10列出了圣灵赐给我们的各种属灵恩赐。

生活在神敞开的天窗之下的六个圣经原则：

1. 成为一个施予者

圣经上说：「你们要给人，就必有给你们，并且用十足的升斗，连摇带按、上尖下流地倒在你怀里。因为你们用什么量器量给人，也必用什么量器量给你们」(路6:38)。藉著施予或播种你得到和收获丰收。当我们施予神，祂丰富的赐给我们。圣经上说：「它就上尖下流地倒在你怀里」。

奉献是你敬拜的表达

博士们献礼物给耶稣。圣经上说：「他们看见那星，就大大地欢喜。进了房子，看见小孩子和他母亲马利亚，就俯伏拜那小孩子，揭开宝盒，拿黄金、乳香、没药为礼物献给他」(太2:10-11)。「你要以财物和一切初熟的土产尊荣耶和華，这样，你的仓房必充满有余，你的酒榨有新酒盈溢」(箴3:9-10)。

什一奉献是你作为忠心管家对祂的主权的顺从。圣经上说：「主说：“谁是那忠心有见识的管家，主人派他管理家里的人，按时分粮给他们呢？主人来到，看见仆人这样行，那仆人就有福了」(路12:42-43)。

当你没有给你的奉献和什一奉献时，你夺取了神应得的敬拜和主权。「人岂可夺取神之物呢？你们竟夺取我的供物。你们却说：“我们在何事上夺取你的供物呢？”就是你们在当纳的十分之一和当献的供物上。因你们通国的人都夺取我的供物，咒诅就临到你们身上」(玛3:8-9)。

2. 有正确的优先顺序

圣经上说：「你们要先求他的国和他的义，这些东西都要加给你们了」(太6:33)。让神在你所拥有的一切事上，你的时间，你的恩赐和能力，有优先顺序。这是指，我们应当有正确的心态。思念能荣耀神的事上。圣经上说：「所以，你们若真与基督一同复活，就当求在上面的事，那里有基督坐在神的右边。你们要思念上面的事，不要思念地上的事」(西3:1-2)。

我们不应心怀二意

「只要凭着信心求，一点不疑惑；因为那疑惑的人就像海中的波浪，被风吹动翻腾。这样的人不要想从主那里得什么，心怀二意的人在他一切所行的路上都没有定见」(雅1:6-8)。

3. 不要怕

圣经上说：「因为神赐给我们不是胆怯的心，乃是刚强、仁爱、谨守的心」(提后1:7)。约伯说道：「因我所恐惧的临到我身，我所惧怕的迎我而来」(伯3:25)。

恐惧是一种束缚，让你不能够领受神要给你的东西。你变成一个囚犯，未能得著神所应许你的一切！当我们没有信心，我们不愿意给，因我们对未来的恐惧感。不要让恐惧统治你的心和思想。

有信心的人知道如何施予

我们不应该害怕，因为神保证祂所有的应许。圣经上说：「神非人，必不至说谎；也非人子，必不至后悔。他说话岂不照着行呢？他发言岂不要成就呢？」(民23:19)。「神的应许不论有多少，在基督都是是的，所以借着祂也都是实在的，叫神因我们得荣耀」(林后1:20)。

4. 要有信心

恐惧和信心不是朋友而是敌人。当信心进入的时候，恐惧就离开。神已经给了我们一份信心，它却因著罪而被夺去。我们的罪已得赦免，并且你已经领受了信心。「我凭着所赐我的恩对你们各人说：不要看自己过于所当看的，要照着神所分给各人信心的大小，看得合乎中道」(罗12:3)。

拉撒路的复活

耶稣告诉拉撒路的两位姐姐，他会活下去。她们相信，认为在主的日他将复活。但是耶稣说道：「『你们把石头挪开！』那死人的姐姐马大对他说：“主啊，他现在必是臭了，因为他死了已经四天了。”耶稣说：『我不是对你说过，你若信，就必看见神的荣耀吗？』」(约11:39-40)。相信耶稣。斥责你的恐惧，而看见神的荣耀，不管你的挑战是什么。

万军之耶和華说：「你们要将当纳的十分之一全然送入仓库，使我家有粮，以此试试我，是否为你们敞开心上的窗户倾福于你们，甚至无处可容」(玛3:10)。

信心是赏赐者

圣经上说：「人非有信就不能得神的喜悦，因为到神面前来的人必须信有神，且信祂赏赐那寻求祂的人」(来11:6)。我们被劝勉，「并且不懈怠，总要效法那些凭信心和忍耐承受应许的人」(来6:12)。

当你凭信心顺服时，心里保持平安。

耶稣说道：「你们心里不要忧愁，你们信神，也当信我。我留下平安给你们，我将我的平安赐给你们。我所赐的不像世人所赐的，你们心里不要忧愁，也不要胆怯」(约14:1, 27)。当你没有恐惧，就有信心。不要允许恐惧存在。

5. 遵守你的诺言

神遵守祂的应许。圣经上说：「我口所说的话也必如此，决不徒然返回，却要成就我所喜悦的，在我发它去成就的事上必然亨通」(赛55:11)。「神非人，必不至说谎；也非人子，必不至后悔。他说话岂不照着行呢？他发言岂不要成就呢？」(民23:19)。

如父子

我们必须遵守我们的承诺和誓言，就像神遵守祂的应许。圣经上说：「你向耶和華你的神许愿，偿还不可迟延，因为耶和華你的神必定向你追讨，你不偿还就有罪。你嘴里所出的，就是你口中应许甘心所献的，要照你向耶和華你神所许的愿遵守履行」(申23:21,23)。「你们要以感谢为祭献于神，又要向至高者还你的愿；并要在患难之日求告我，我必搭救你，你也要荣耀我」(诗50:14-15)。

6. 宣告圣经所说的

小心你说的话。圣经上说：「说话浮躁的如刀刺人，智慧人的舌头却为医人的良药」(箴12:18)。「生死在舌头的权下，喜爱它的必吃它所结的果子」(箴18:21)。我们说的话会定罪我们的。所以说生命和说积极美好的话来造就人和彼此建立。当你操练生活在神敞开的天窗之下的原则，你将体验到神兴盛的祝福。神要祝福你，以便你可以成为祂祝福的管道为祂的国度去触摸生命。你可以遵行神的旨意，并看到神在你的生命中的异象被完成！我们是有命定的人。
