BE OF GOOD CHEER -

Educators teach by using whiteboards, pictures, charts and other tools. When Jesus taught, He referred to nature - the birds, fields, trees and so on. He told parables, referring to people, events, incidents and circumstances to teach about the Kingdom of God. On one occasion, even without microphones then, He taught to thousands at the feeding of the 5,000. He taught individuals, including, Nicodemus and the rich young ruler.

The Bible is good for learning and teaching. The Bible says, "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17). This is why Calvary Church believes in preaching and teaching the Word of God, so you can know and experience the truth.

I would like to draw your attention to the following text in Scripture. "Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away. And when He had sent the multitudes away, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray. Now when evening came, He was alone there. But the boat was now in the middle of the sea, tossed by

the waves, for the wind was contrary. Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, 'It is a ghost!' And they cried out for fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.' And Peter answered Him and said, 'Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water.' So He said, 'Come.' And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, 'Lord, save me.' And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, 'O you of little faith, why did you doubt?' And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. Then those who were in the boat came and worshiped Him, saying, 'Truly You are the Son of God"" (Matthew 14:22-33). For many, this account seems to highlight Peter's failure or lack of faith. But it is actually a powerful teaching on faith that works. Walking on water is simply having faith in what God says and trusting in the power of God rather than being dictated by our situation or condition.

Like Peter, you may have stepped out of your boat in obedience to God's Word and now you are faced with human reality. Whatever your storm may be, a boisterous marriage, health issues, business, battling to live righteously, finances, or whatever else. You had faith to obey Him to get out of your boat, and now you find yourself sinking!

Let's learn from Peter's situation.

BE COURAGEOUS

God Wants You To Understand Two Things.

FIRST, THE STORM WAS **ABOUT FAITH AND NOT** ABOUT NO FAITH.

Peter was the only one who stepped out of the boat in response to Jesus invitation, "Come" (Matthew 24:29). The winds were boisterous, not because he was disobedient, but on the contrary, he acted in obedience by faith. He did walk on water, but when he looked around and saw the winds becoming boisterous, he began to sink. Does this not sound familiar? We start out in faith but depend on our human wisdom, ability and natural senses to dictate to us.

We face adverse circumstances in life, not necessarily out of disobedience or for lack of faith. For faith to be faith, we have to face adverse circumstances. Faith works best in impossible situations, for with God all things are possible. Why do you need faith, if there is no storm? Storms prove our faith and faith grows out of our relationship with Jesus.

Our faith permits us to face Goliath, the walls of Jericho,

mountains and even face lions. Faith causes us to obey His Word and believe God is able to do what is impossible for us. That is why Jesus said, "Come" and when Peter cried out, "Save me", immediately, Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" (Matthew 14:30-31). When you get into trouble, Jesus will respond to you immediately, when you act in faith, though it may be little. "Immediately" may not always be "right away" in some cases, but it shows He acts on your faith.

SECOND, JESUS DID NOT NEED TO WALK ON WATER. BUT HE DID, TO **TEACH YOU ABOUT** FAITH.

Jesus was using this occasion to teach us about putting our faith into action, for faith without works is dead (James 2:17). Therefore, when we act in obedience by faith, don't murmur, complain, frustrated or lose your sense of balance. Jesus tells us faith and action makes our faith complete (James 2:22, NIV).

Three Vital Truths About Walking In Faith.

TRUTH 1: "BE OF GOOD CHEER" (Matthew 14:27) or TAKE COURAGE.

The Bible says, "And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out for fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid" (Matthew 14:26-27). God said the same to Joshua, when he led the children of Israel into the Promised Land. "Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go" (Joshua 1:6,7). To have Jesus with us, is the greatest and the most comforting assurance one can ever have. The Bible says, "Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with

you. He will not leave you nor forsake you" (Deuteronomy 31:6).

TRUTH 2: "IT IS I" (Matthew 14:27) or "I AM WITH YOU".

The problem with the Church is when Jesus comes in a manner beyond our expectation speaks through the Holy Spirit, we fail to acknowledge Him and miss the blessings of God. You would have imagined that the disciples would have known better having been with Jesus. Jesus had to tell them, "It is I; do not be afraid". They did not have to fear anything because Jesus was with them. The truth about the importance of having God's presence is illustrated in Moses' desire for God's presence in all he did. Moses said to God, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here" (Exodus 33:15) and God said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest" (Exodus 33:14).

THE PRESENCE OF GOD WILL BRING:

The Provision of God

When you have faith in God, and in a storm or sinking, God will show up. And where God is, His provisions are available to you. When Peter stepped out of the boat by faith and began to sink, he cried out to Jesus. Jesus immediately stretched out His hand to save him. In

God's provision, we will have what we need.

The Power of God

The Bible says, "And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased" (Matthew 14:32). God's power is for those who have a need, those who are sinking, the weak and the faint. The apostle Paul said, "Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities ... in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when. I am weak, than I am strong" (2 Corinthians 12:10).

The Purpose of God

The Bible says, "Then those who were in the boat came and worshiped Him, saying, 'Truly You are the Son of God" (Matthew 14:33). As soon as they entered the boat the wind ceased. The disciples recognised Jesus' authority over nature worshipped Him. The purpose of God showing up is so we will acknowledge and worship Him. Worship belongs to God. When faith arises within you, you worship Him. In every crisis of life, God has a miracle for you.

TRUTH 3: DO NOT BE AFRAID.

Peter said, "Lord, if, it is You, command me to come to You on the water. So He said, 'Come'" (Matthew 14:28-29). Walking in faith involves hearing, knowing and doing God's will. The Bible says,

"Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17). Faith is always built on God's Word. And the Word in this occasion is "Come". Peter did walk on the water, he walked in faith. Always exercise faith in God's Word. The Bible says, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away" (Matthew 24:35). Jesus recognised Peter's faith.

It is our responsibility to simply do what He says. Act on His promises. He is a promise keeper. Be encouraged too by this wonderful promise, "'No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is from Me,' says the Lord" (Isaiah 54:17).

Every Sunday, scores of Calvarites sit around tables at the Olive Café at Basement 2 of Calvary Convention Centre (CCC), enjoying a simple Malaysian breakfast at affordable prices. They catch up with family and friends and make new acquaintances. The café is led by the women in the Dimensions Ministry.

This ministry of providing simple meals before and after Sunday Worship Services began in 2013 with the Father's Day Bazaar where the women participated in setting up stalls. They then ran a regular breakfast stall every first Sunday of the month at the covered plaza.

In June 2015, with the encouragement of Senior Associate Pastor Petrina Guneratnam, a faithful team of women came together and agreed to take up the challenge of running the canteen at Basement 2 as a ministry. Toh Poh Guat, who joined the team a few months ago says enthusiastically, "I find it refreshing and fulfilling even though I have to wake up at 6am on Sundays."

Magdalene Foo, one of longest serving says, "I have enjoyed serving in the café these past two years. I enjoy baking the sausage puffs which is a sell-out every week."

The café is also a blessing to those serving in ministry. Lee Bee Peng says, "My daughter and I are always in a rush to reach CCC before 7.30am each Sunday for the Teens and Carpenters' Workshop worship practice. We are so blessed with delicious breakfasts prepared early by a team of faithful Calvarites."


One of his achievements was Top 2016 SPM scorer.

BERSUKACITALAH -TABAHKAN DIRI

Pendidik mengajar dengan menggunakan papanputih, gambar-gambar, carta-carta dan peralatan lain. Ketika Yesus mengajar, Dia merujuk kepada alam sekitar – burung-burung, padang, pokok-pokok dan sebagainya. Dia menggunakan perumpamaan, merujuk kepada manusia, peristiwa, kejadian dan keadaan tertentu untuk mengajar akan Kerajaan Tuhan. Pada satu ketika, tanpa mikrofon pun, Dia mengajar ribuan semasa membekalkan makanan kepada 5,000 orang. Dia mengajar individu, termasuk Nikodemus dan raia kaya yang muda.

Alkitab sesuai untuk pengajaran dan pembelajaran. Alkitab menyatakan "Segala tulisan yang diilhamkan Tuhan memang bermanfaat untuk mengajar, untuk menyatakan kesalahan, untuk memperbaiki kelakuan dan untuk mendidik orang dalam kebenaran" (2 Timotius 3:16-17). Ini sebabnya kenapa Gereja Calvari percaya dalam mengkhutbah dan mengajar Firman Tuhan, agar kamu dapat mengetahui dan mengalami kebenaran.

Saya mahu membawa perhatian kamu kepada teks Alkitab berikut "Sesudah itu Yesus segera memerintahkan murid-murid-Nya naik ke perahu dan mendahului-Nya ke seberang, sementara itu la menyuruh orang banyak pulang. Dan setelah orang banyak itu disuruh-Nya pulang, Yesus naik ke atas bukit untuk berdoa seorang diri. Ketika hari sudah malam. la sendirian di situ. Perahu muridmurid-Nya sudah beberapa jauhnya dari pantai dan diombangambingkan gelombang, karena angin sakal. Kira-kira jam tiga malam datanglah Yesus kepada mereka berjalan di atas air. Ketika murid-murid-Nya melihat Dia berjalan di atas air, mereka terkejut dan berseru: "Itu hantu!", lalu berteriakteriak karena takut. Tetapi segera Yesus berkata kepada mereka: "Tenanglah! Aku ini, jangan takut!" Lalu Petrus berseru dan menjawab Dia: "Tuhan, apabila Engkau itu,

suruhlah aku datang kepada-Mu berjalan di atas air." Kata Yesus: "Datanglah!" Maka Petrus turun dari perahu dan berjalan di atas air mendapatkan Yesus. Tetapi ketika dirasanya tiupan angin, takutlah ia dan mulai tenggelam lalu berteriak: "Tuhan, tolonglah aku!" Segera Yesus mengulurkan tangan-Nya, memegang dia dan berkata: "Hai orang yang kurang percaya, mengapa engkau bimbang?" Lalu mereka naik ke perahu dan anginpun redalah. Dan orang-orang yang ada di perahu menyembah Dia, katanya: "Sesungguhnya Engkau Anak Tuhan" (Matius 14:22-33). Bagai ramai orang, peristiwa ini bagaikan menonjolkan kegagalan atau ketiadaan iman dari pihak Petrus. Tetapi sebenarnya ia adalah satu pengajaran yang penting tentang iman yang berhasil. Berjalan diatas air bermakna memiliki iman dalam apa vang dikatakan oleh Tuhan daripada dipengaruhi oleh situasi atau kondisi kita sendiri.

Seperti Petrus, kamu mungkin telah melangkah keluar daripada perahu kerana mentaati Firman Tuhan dan kini kamu berdepan dengan realiti. Apa sekalipun ribut kamu, rumahtangga bergelora, isu kesihatan. perniagaan, bergelut mahu hidup dalam kebenaran, kewangan, atau apa sekalipun. Kamu mempunyai iman mentaati Dia untuk keluar dari perahu kamu, dan kini dapati kamu sendiri tenggelam!

Marilah pelajari daripada situasi Petrus.

Tuhan Mahu Kamu Memahami Dua Perkara.

PERTAMA, RIBUT ITU ADALAH **TENTANG IMAN DAN BUKANNYA** TENTANG KETIADAAN IMAN.

Petrus seorang sahaja yang melangkah keluar dari perahu ekoran pelawaan Kristus, "Datanglah!" (Matius 14:29). Angin kencang, bukan kerana dia ingkar, tetapi sebaliknya, dia bertindak mematuhi dalam iman. Dia berjalan di atas air, tetapi apabila dia melihat kiri kanan dan nampak akan angin kencang, dia mulai tenggelam. Adakah ini sesuatu yang pernah didengari? Kita mulai dengan iman tetapi bergantung atas kebijaksanaan manusia, kebolehan dan deria semulajadi untuk menquasai kita.

Kita hadapi keadaan rencam dalam kehidupan, tidak semestinya kerana ketidakpatuhan atau kekurangan iman. Agar iman adalah iman sejati, kita terpaksa hadapi kerencaman kehidupan. Iman menonjol dalam situasi yang mustahil, kerana dengan Tuhan semuanya mungkin. Kenapa kamu perlukan iman, sekiranya tiada ribut? Ribut membuktikan iman kita dan iman bertumbuh hasil perhubungan kita dengan Yesus.

Iman kita membolehkan kita berdepan dengan Goliat, tembok Jeriko, gunung dan juga berdepan dengan singa. Iman menyebabkan kita patuhi Firman Tuhan dan percaya Tuhan boleh melakukan untuk kita apa yang agak mustahil. Sebab itulah Yesus berkata, "Datanglah" dan apabila Petrus berteriak, "Tolonglah aku", segera Yesus mengulurkan tanganNya, memegang dia dan berkata: "Hai orang yang kurang percaya, mengapa engkau bimbang?" (Matius 14:30-31). Apabila kamu dalam kesusahan, Yesus akan bertindak balas segera, apabila kamu bertindak dalam iman, mahupun ianya sedikit. "Segera" bukan selalunya "serta merta" dalam keadaan tertentu, tetapi ia menunjukkan Dia bertindak atas iman kamu

KEDUA. YESUS TIDAK PERLU BERJALAN DIATAS AIR. NAMUN IA **MELAKUKANNYA. UNTUK** MENGAJAR KAMU TENTANG IMAN.

Yesus menggunakan situasi ini untuk mengajar kita supaya bertindak dalam iman, kerana iman tanpa perbuatan hakikatnya mati (Yakobus 2:17). Oleh itu, apabila kita taat bertindak dalam iman, jangan merungut, bersungut, berputus asa atau hilana keseimbangan. Yesus memberitahu kita, "Iman bekeriasama dengan perbuatan-perbuatan oleh dan perbuatan-perbuatan itu iman menjadi sempurna" (Yakobus 2:22).

Tiga Kebenaran Yang Penting Tentang Berjalan Dalam Iman.

KEBENARAN 1: "BERSUKACITALAH" (Matius 14:27) atau TABAHKAN DIRI.

Alkitab menyatakan, "Ketika muridmurid-Nya melihat Dia berjalan di atas air, mereka terkejut dan berseru: "Itu hantu!", lalu berteriak-teriak karena takut. Tetapi segera Yesus berkata kepada mereka: "Tenanglah! Aku ini, jangan takut!" (Matius 14:26-27). Tuhan berkata yang sama kepada Yosua, apabila dia memimpin bangsa Israel memasuki Tanah Yang Dijanjikan. "Kuatkan dan teguhkanlah hatimu, sebab engkaulah yang akan memimpin bangsa ini memiliki negeri yang Kujanjikan dengan bersumpah kepada nenek moyang mereka untuk diberikan kepada mereka. Hanya, kuatkan dan teguhkanlah hatimu dengan sungguh-sungguh, bertindaklah hati-hati sesuai dengan seluruh hukum yang telah diperintahkan kepadamu oleh hamba-Ku Musa; janganlah menyimpang ke kanan atau ke kiri, supaya engkau beruntung, ke manapun engkau pergi" (Yosua 1:6,7). Mempunyai Yesus bersama kita, adalah jaminan yang paling baik dan yang menghiburkan yang boleh seseorang perolehi. Alkitab menyatakan, "Kuatkan dan teguhkanlah hatimu, janganlah takut dan jangan gemetar karena mereka, sebab TUHAN, Tuhanmu, Dialah yang berjalan menyertai engkau; la tidak akan membiarkan engkau dan tidak akan meninggalkan engkau" (Ulangan 31:6).

KEBENARAN 2: "INI AKU" (Matius 14:27) atau "AKU BERSAMAMU".

Masalah dengan gereja adalah apabila Yesus datang dengan cara di luar jangkaan dan bercakap melalui Roh Kudus, kita gagal mengakuiNya menyebabkan kita melepasi berkat-Nya. Kamu mungkin menjangka murid Kristus sudah pasti mengenali Yesus kerana lama bersamaNva. Yesus terpaksa memberitahu mereka "Aku Ini, jangan takut". Mereka tidak perlu takut apa sekalipun kerana Yesus bersama mereka. Kebenaran akan kepentingan berada dalam hadirat Tuhan dipamerkan dalam keinginan Musa akan hadirat Tuhan dalam segala apa yang dia lakukan. Musa berkata kepada Tuhan, "Jika Engkau sendiri tidak membimbing kami, janganlah suruh kami berangkat dari sini" (Keluaran 33:14-15) dan Tuhan berkata, "Aku sendiri hendak membimbing engkau dan memberikan ketenteraman kepadamu" (Keluaran 33:14-15).

HADIRAT TUHAN AKAN **MEMBAWA:**

• Pembekalan Tuhan

Apabila kamu meletakkan iman dalam Tuhan, maupun dalam badai atau tenggelam, Tuhan akan muncul. Juga di mana Tuhan berada, bekalanNya terbuka luas kepada kamu. Apabila Petrus melangkah keluar dari perahu dalam iman dan mulai tenggelam, dia memanagil Yesus. Yesus segera menghulur tanganNya untuk menyelamatkan dia. Dalam bekalan Tuhan, kita akan peroleh apa yang kita perlukan.

• Kuasa Tuhan

Alkitab menyatakan, "Lalu mereka naik ke perahu dan anginpun redalah" (Matius 14:32). Kuasa Tuhan untuk mereka yang mempunyai keperluan, mereka yang tenggelam, yang lemah dan yang dalam keraguan. Paulus berkata, "Karena itu aku senang dan rela di dalam kelemahan, di dalam siksaan, di dalam kesukaran, di dalam penganiayaan dan kesesakan oleh karena Kristus. Sebab jika aku lemah, maka aku kuat" (2 Korintus 12:10).

Matlamat Tuhan Adalah Untuk Kita MenyembahNya

Alkitab menyatakan, "Dan orangorang yang ada di perahu menyembah Dia, katanya: "Sesungguhnya Engkau Anak Tuhan" (Matius 14:33). Sebaik sahaja mereka menaiki perahu angin pun reda. Murid Kristus ketahui autoritas Yesus atas alam semulajadi dan menyembah Dia. Matlamat Tuhan muncul supaya kita akan mengenal dan menyembah Dia. Penyembahan adalah milik Tuhan. Apabila iman bangkit dalammu, kamu menvembahNva. Dalam setiap krisis kehidupan, Tuhan mempunyai mukjizat bagi kamu.

KEBENARAN 3: JANGANLAH TAKUT

Petrus berkata. "Tuhan, apabila Engkau itu, suruhlah aku datang kepada-Mu berjalan di atas air. Kata Yesus: "Datanglah!" (Matius 14:28-29). Berialan dalam iman melibatkan pendengaran, pengenalan dan perlakuan kehendak Tuhan. Alkitab menyatakan, "Jadi, iman timbul dari pendengaran, dan pendengaran oleh firman Kristus" (Roma 10:17). Iman selalu dibina atas Firman Tuhan, Dan firman untuk ketika ini "Datanglah". Petrus pernah berjalan di atas air, dia berjalan dalam iman. Selalu praktikkan iman dalam Firman Tuhan. Alkitab menyatakan, "Langit dan bumi akan berlalu, tetapi perkataan-Ku tidak akan berlalu (Matius 14:35). Yesus mengesahkan iman Petrus.

Adalah tanggungjawab kita untuk melakukan apa yang dikatakanNya. Bertindak atas janji-janjiNya. Dia pemegang janji. Didorong juga dengan janji indah ini, "Setiap senjata yang ditempa terhadap engkau tidak akan berhasil, dan setiap orang yang melontarkan tuduhan melawan engkau dalam pengadilan, akan engkau buktikan salah. Inilah yang menjadi bagian hamba-hamba TUHAN dan kebenaran yang mereka terima dari pada-Ku, demikianlah firman TUHAN" (Yesaya 54:17).

你们放心-要有勇气

教育工作者使用白板、图片、图表 和其他工具进行教学。当耶稣教导 的时候。他提到自然界 一 鸟。田野 , 树木等等。他讲比喻, 提到人, 活动、事件和环境来教导神的国。 有一次,即使没有麦克风,在喂饱 五千人的事迹中他教导了数以千计 的人。他教导个人,包括尼哥底母 和富有年轻的官。

圣经对学习和教导都是有益的。圣经上说: 「圣经都是神所默示的,于教训、督责、使人 归正、教导人学义都是有益的,叫属神的人得 以完全, 预备行各样的善事」(提后3:16-17) 。这就是为什么加略山教会相信传讲和教导神 的话语,这样你可以认识和经历真理。

我想请你注意以下的圣经经文。

「耶稣随即催门徒上船,先渡到对岸,等他叫 众人散去。疏散了众人以后,他独自上山去祷 告。到了晚上,只有他一人在那里。那时船已 离岸好几里, 因风不顺, 被浪颠簸。天快亮的 时候,耶稣在海面上走,往门徒那里去。但门 徒看见他在海面上走,就惊慌了,说: "是个 鬼怪!"他们害怕得喊叫起来。耶稣连忙对他 们说:"放心!是我,不要怕!"彼得回答他说 : "主啊,如果是你,请叫我从水面上走到你 那里去。" 耶稣说: "你来吧!" 彼得就从船 上下去,在水面上走,往耶稣那里去;只因见 风很强,害怕起来,将要沉下去,就喊着说: '主啊,救我!" 耶稣立刻伸手拉住他,说 : "你这小信的人哪,为什么疑惑呢?" 们一上船,风就停了。在船上的人都拜他,说 你真是神的儿子。"」(太14:22-33)。 对许多人来说,这个叙述似乎强调了彼得的失 败或缺乏信心。但它实际上是一个大有能力的 教导关于有果效的信心。在水面上走, 就是要 对神所说的话有信心和信靠神的大能, 而不是 由我们的情况或环境来决定。

就像彼得一样, 你可能顺从神的话已经从你的 船上下去, 在水面上走, 现在你面对人类现实 一面。无论你面对的风暴是什么,一场喧闹的 婚姻, 健康问题, 生意, 与过公义的生活, 理 财或任何其他事情斗争。你有信心顺从他从你 的船上下去,现在你发现自己要沉下去!

让我们从彼得的情况学习。

神要你明白两件事。

首先, 这场风暴是关于信心, 而不是没有信心。

彼得是唯一一个回应耶稣的激请「你来吧」 就从船上下去的人(太24:29)。猛烈的风,不 是因为他不顺从,情况正相反,他因着信顺从 。他在水面上行走, 但是当他环顾四周, 看到 风变得很强烈时, 他开始沉下去。这听起来不 是很熟悉吗? 我们从信心开始, 但依赖于我们 人的智慧, 能力和自然的感官来支配我们。

我们面对生活中的逆境, 不一定是由于不顺从 或缺乏信心。因着信心为信心,我们必须面对 逆境。信心在不可能的情况下最有果效,因在 神凡事都可能。如果没有风暴,你为什么需要 信心呢? 风暴证明我们的信心和信心是从我们 与耶稣的关系中生长出来。

我们的信心允许我们面对歌利亚, 耶利哥的城 墙,大山甚至面对狮子。信心使我们顺从衪的 话语,相信神能够为我们成全不可能的事。这 就是为什么耶稣说:「你来吧」, 而当彼得大声 喊着说:「主啊, 救我」, 耶稣立即伸手, 拉住 他,对他说:「你这小信的人哪,为什么疑惑呢 ? 」 (太14:30-31)。 当你陷入困境时, 因着你 的信心耶稣会立即回应你, 尽管它可能是小信 。在某些情况下,「立即」并不总是「马上」, 但这显示他是因你的信心行事。

第二、耶稣不需要在水面上走。 但他这么做为要教你关于信心的事。

耶稣正在用这个场合教导我们把我们的信心付 诸行动, 因为没有行为的信心是死的(雅2:17) 。 因此, 当我们以信心顺从行事时, 不要发怨 言,抱怨,沮丧或失去平衡感。耶稣告诉我们: 「信心是因着行为才得以成全的」(雅2:22)。

关于信心生活的三个重要直理。

第一个真理:「放心」(太14:27) 或者要有勇气。

圣经上说:「但门徒看见他在海面上走, 就惊慌 了. 说: "是个鬼怪!" 他们害怕得喊叫起来。耶 稣连忙对他们说:"放心!是我,不要怕!"」(太14:26-27)。当约书亚带领以色列人进入应许 之地时, 神对他说:「你当刚强壮胆, 因为你必 使这百姓承受那地为业, 就是我向他们列祖起 誓要给他们的地。只要刚强, 大大壮胆, 谨守遵 行我仆人摩西所吩咐你的一切律法, 不可偏离 左右, 使你无论往哪里去, 都可以顺利」(书 1:6-7)。有耶稣与我们同在,是最伟大也是最令 人欣慰的保证。圣经上说:「你们当刚强壮胆, 不要害怕, 也不要畏惧他们, 因为耶和华 - 你的 神必与你同去; 他必不撇下你, 也不丢弃你。」 (申31:6)。

第二个真理:「是我」(太14:27) 或「我与你同在」。

教会的问题是, 当耶稣以超出我们期望的方式 来到,并通过圣灵说话时,我们没有承认袖,而 错过神的祝福。你会想象到门徒们因与耶稣在 一起, 必会认出耶稣。耶稣却必须告诉他们: 「 是我,不要怕」。他们不必惧怕任何事,因为 耶稣与他们在一起。有关神同在的重要性的真 理之例证是在摩西的渴望,求神在他所行的一 切事上有神与他同在。摩西对神说:「你若不 亲自去,就不要把我们从这里领上去。」 出33:14-15)和神说:「我必亲自去、让你安 心」(出33:14-15)。

神的同在会带来

· 神的供应

当你对神有信心, 在暴风雨或沉没的时候, 神会 出现。神在哪里,就有祂为你预备的供应。当彼 得因着信心从船上下去, 开始沉下时, 他向耶稣 呼求。耶稣立即伸出手来拯救他。在神的供应 中. 我们将有我们所需要的。

· 神的大能

圣经上说: 「他们一上船, 风就停了」(太 14:32)。神的大能力是给有需要的人, 那些正 在沉没的人, 软弱和胆怯的人。使徒保罗说:「 为基督的缘故, 我以软弱、凌辱、艰难、迫害 、困苦为可喜乐的事; 因为我什么时候软弱, 什么时候就刚强了」(林后12:10)。

· 神对我们的目的是敬拜他

圣经上说:「在船上的人都拜他,说:"你真 是神的儿子"」(太14:33)。一旦他们一上 船,风就停止了。门徒们承认耶稣对自然界的 权柄, 并敬拜他。神显现的目的乃是要我们会 承认和敬拜他。敬拜是属于神。当信心在你心 里兴起时,你就敬拜他。在生命的每一个危机 中, 神为你预备了一个神迹。

第三个直理: 不要怕。

彼得说: 「主啊, 如果是你, 请叫我从水面上 走到你那里去。耶稣说:"你来吧"」(太 14:28-29)。信心的生活中涉及听,知道和遵 行神的旨意。圣经说:「可见, 信道是从听道来 的, 听道是从基督的话来的」(罗10:17)。信 心永远是建立在神的话语之上。 在这个场合 神的话是「你来吧」。彼得在水面上走,他凭 信心走。经常操练对神的话语的信心。圣经上 说:「天地要废去,我的话却绝不废去」(太 24:35)。耶稣看见彼得的信心。

我们有责任去遵行他所说的话。遵照他的应许 行动。他是一位守约者。让这个美好的应许勉 励我们, 「凡为攻击你而造的兵器必无效用; 在审判时兴起用口舌攻击你的,你必驳倒他。 这是耶和华仆人的产业, 是他们从我所得的义; 这是耶和华说的」 (赛54:17)。
