

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Keys To Rejoicing Faith

And not only that,

but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance,

character; and character, hope.

Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us."

Romans 5:1-5

God wants you to be victorious.

He desires that you win every time you are in "battle", regardless of the circumstances. "For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that overcomes the world-our faith" (1 John 5:4). God's purpose and will for you is that you be an overcomer. In the book of Revelation, Jesus told the apostle John to write to seven churches. Jesus pointed out what they lacked and gave them the solution to come out of their sinful state. Jesus' message to them was. "He who overcomes shall inherit all things and I will be His God

things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us" (Romans 8:37).

The apostle Paul gives three reasons why nothing should get you down:

1. God is for you. "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?" (Romans 8:31). You cannot lose if God is on vour side. You and God are the majority.

2. God justifies you in Christ. "Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies" (Romans 8:33). Satan is the accuser and he will bring all manner of accusations against you. But God has provided salvation through

the work of Christ on the cross. Jesus has paid the price for all your sins. "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

3. Christ intercedes for you.

"Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us" (Romans 8:34). At the worst of times, when you face severe pressures and temptations and you are unable, or have no desire to pray, Christ is interceding for you. And if Christ is interceding for you, how can you lose? You will be a victor. Therefore believe and rejoice!

Let me share with you four keys to rejoicing faith, according to Paul in Romans 5:1-5.

The First Key: Know your position.

In Romans 5:1-2, Paul says: "Therefore having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have access by faith into His grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God."

Senior Pastor is the New Chairman of CFM!

The Christian Federation of Malaysia (CFM) is the official representative of the Christian community in Malaysia to the government. It comprises the Catholic Church in Malaysia, Council of Churches Malaysia and National Evangelical Christian Fellowship (NECF) Malaysia.

On Saturday, 24 February 2001, our Senior Pastor Prince Guneratnam, currently NECF Malaysia Chairman, was elected the new Chairman of CFM for a two-year period beginning 2001. He replaced Archbishop Datuk Yong Ping Chung, who has served in the capacity for the last two biennial terms.

In his maiden speech, Senior
Pastor Guneratnam said that for CFM to
be beneficial and to fulfil its purpose, we
must live the gospel, growing in love,
trust and faith towards God and each
other. He also said that CFM needs to
be seen and heard as an advocate of
the gospel and a vehicle for cooperation
and fellowship.

We congratulate our Senior Pastor and rejoice with him over this new responsibility. Let us remember to uphold him in prayer as he holds a significant position as the leader of the whole Christian community in our country. Pray for God's wisdom and the Holy Spirit's guidance as he carries out his responsibilities.

He said, "We cannot let the world move into a supersonic jet and computerised age of IT while the church is left behind in the horse and cart or the bullock-cart age. We cannot bury our heads in the sand like an ostrich and believe all is well." "We hope," he added, "the call for this Consultation will challenge us to be at the cutting edge and also be a witness that we care and are concerned about the future and the relevance of the Gospel." He then prayed for God's blessing upon our rulers, our government, the Consultation, the international speakers and friends present.





Soul Care

Soul Care Seminar 7,8 & 10 March 2001

When a friend or a loved one presents us with a problem, we are often left feeling helpless. We desire to help but feel at a loss as to how best to provide the needed assistance. Sometimes we suggest counselling, but that may leave us feeling like we have absconded from the responsibility as a friend. What can we do? Surely as Christians we can do more.

A hundred and fifty people attended the three sessions conducted by Dr. David and Juliet Benner. Their message—all of us need soul care; the good news—every Christian can provide it. Soul care comes in many different forms—proclaiming the Word, preaching, guiding someone to make wise choices or helping someone to heal from emotional hurts which is a form of counselling. However, the focus of the seminar was on Spiritual Direction as a form of soul care.

Another word for Spiritual Direction is accompaniment. The focus is not on finding a solution to a problem but rather attending to the work and presence of God in a person's life. As a Christian, we believe that God's presence is always with us even when we go through the dark valleys of life and that everything works together for good for those of us who love God and desire to do His will. Therefore, as Spiritual Directors we can help people recognise and be attentive to God's presence in the midst of their struggles, hurts and pains. Case studies as well as extensive notes were used to illustrate the skills involved.

The Soul Care Seminar was organised by **Calvary Life Ministries (CLM)**, the counselling arm of Calvary
Church. CLM organises annual counselling seminars for
Christian counsellors as well as for the Church at large.
The seminar was followed by a retreat for the lay
counsellors. It is the desire of each of the CLM
counsellors that we provide the best of Christian
counselling and spiritual direction is part of what we do.


Everyone of us felt that all the hard work, late nights and sacrifice were worth it all!



In conclusion, Dr. Cole encouraged the men to be involved and to participate in the Men's LG activities and be a blessing to others. The men were blessed and responded by making commitments to do that. They then adjourned for a good breakfast followed by a bowling and golf session with Dr. Cole!

「我們既因信稱義,就藉著我們的主耶穌基督得與上帝相和。我們又藉著祂,因信得進入現在所站的這恩典中,並且歡歡喜喜盼望上帝的榮耀。不但如此,就是在患難中也是歡歡喜喜的;因為知道患難生忍耐,忍耐生老練,老練生盼望;盼望不至於羞恥,因為所賜給我們的聖靈將上帝的愛澆灌在我們心里」(羅五1-5)。

使徒保羅以三個理由解釋無論什麼事都 不能叫你失敗:

1。上帝是為你的。「既是這樣,還有什麼說的呢?上帝若幫助我們,誰能敵擋我們呢?」(羅八31)。若上帝是為你的,你就不會失敗的。你和上帝聯合就必能得勝。

2。上帝在基督里使你稱義。「誰能控告上帝所揀選的人呢?有上帝稱他們為義了」(羅八33)。撒但是那控告者,牠會提起各種各類的控告來為難你。但是上帝已經藉著基督在十字架上的工作預備了救恩。耶穌已經為你還清所有的罪債。(徒四12)。

3。基督為我們祈求。「誰能定他們的 罪呢?有基督耶穌已經死了,而且從死 里復活,現今在上帝的右邊,也替我 們祈求」(羅八34)。在最艱難的時刻, 當你面對重大的壓力和誘惑,沒有能力 或不想要祈禱時,基督正為你祈求。如 果有基督在為你代求,你又如何會失敗 呢?你將成為勝利者。因此要相信和歡 喜!

讓我依照保羅在羅馬書五1-5的教導與你分享四個歡喜信心的要訣。

第一個要訣: 認識你的地位

在羅五1-2,保羅說,「我們既因信稱義,就藉著我們的主耶穌基督得與上帝相和。我們又藉著祂,因信得進入現在所站的這恩典中,並且歡歡喜喜盼望上帝的榮耀。」保羅鑒定了三項重要的事實,是關於你身為信徒的地位。

第一,你已經因信稱義。罪將你與上帝隔絕,但是上帝的救恩解決了罪和隔離的問題。上帝賜給你祂的兒子耶穌,為你的罪流血受罰。當你相信耶穌時,你不但罪被赦免,而且有如無罪。這正如法庭宣告你無罪釋放一樣。當上帝看你,祂視你是毫無過失,因為耶穌擔當

了你的罪(弗一 4-5)。「上帝使那無罪的,替我們成為罪 ,好叫我們在他里面成為上帝的義」(林後五 21)。你已經因信被稱為義,有如亞伯拉罕一樣當他相信上帝的時候就被算為義(羅四 3)。

第二,你得與上帝相和。在你未信主前,你因心里悖逆與上帝為敵。你過著自我的生活。可是上帝召喚你,當你相信耶穌時你與祂的關係得到恢復。你被重生在上帝屬靈的家中。你作上帝的孩子得與上帝相和。「你們從前遠離上帝的人,如今卻在基督耶穌里,靠著祂的血,已經得親近了」(弗二13)。

第三,你因信得進入祂的恩典中。認識你已經被稱為義及得與上帝相和,你就能夠來到祂面前。你現在得進入上帝的恩典中得到你所需要的恩惠。(來四16)。知道你有權利來到上帝的面前,你可以相信上帝是不會使你失望。你可以為你一切的需要來信靠祂。

第二個要款 **堅忍和讓忍耐完成它的工** 作。

第三個要訣: 明白盼望的作用

不信者有句諺語説,「坐以待斃」。這樣的盼望是何等的令人灰心失望—他們所盼望的是死亡!但是對基督徒來說,「…盼望不至於羞恥,因為所賜給心里」(羅五5)。當你的信心受到考驗時成是人羅五5)。當你的信心受到考驗時就是重要的是你不可失去盼望。「信據是所望之事的實底,是未見之事的確據。古人在這信上得了美好的證據」(要成一1-2)。信心和盼望是孿生的。要成

為得勝者,你不能只擁有 其中一項。 你的信心是建立在上帝的話語之上。盼 望能給你想象力使它實現。

如果你沒有盼望,你將會失去你的信心。撒但因此要攻擊你使你逐漸喪失你的盼望。當一個人失去他的健康,他就不方便。當他失去健康時,他就停為無能。當他的盼望被奪去時,他就停止下來,沒有能力活動。當耶穌在曠野受話抱有盼望—「經上記著說」。你許認的話語有信心,並對祂所應的抱有盼望。你必須要有信心的盼望。

第四個要訣: 領會上帝的愛

當你遇見困難時,撒但會暗示是上帝並不愛你。不要讓牠成功地使你懷疑或質疑上帝。反而,祈求聖靈以祂的愛來充滿你。「誰能使我們與基督的愛隔絕呢?…然而,靠著愛我們的主,在這一切的事上已經得勝有餘了」(羅八35-37)。保羅說,「…因為所賜給我們的聖靈將上帝的愛澆灌在我們心里」(羅五5)。

只要你活著,從肉體,世界和魔鬼而來的壓力會向你發出挑戰。但是贊美主,你藉著基督能夠戰勝。相信和歡喜!讓喜樂成為你的信心的表達。



Firstly, you have been justified by faith. Sin separates you from God but God's salvation deals with the sin and separation. God gave His Son, Jesus Christ, to take the punishment for your sins with His precious blood. When you believe in Jesus, you are not only forgiven but it is as if you have not done wrong. It is like you have been acquitted in the court of law. When God looks at you, He sees you as blameless because Jesus took your sins. "...He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will (Ephesians 1:4-5). "For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us. that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (2 Corinthians 5:21). You have been made righteous by faith in the same way Abraham was counted as righteous when he believed in God. "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness (Romans 4:3).

Secondly, you have peace with God. Before you were a believer, you were an enemy of God because of rebellion in your heart. You walked in your own ways. But God reached out to you and your relationship with Him was restored when you

work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing" (James 1:4).

In a weightlifting championship, a weightlifter who can lift the heaviest weight is the winner. He takes his position and places his hands on the bar in preparation to lift the weights. Finally, he picks the weights up to his shoulders and to win, he has to lift them over his head. Once he does that, he immediately throws it down. When the pressures of life come, do not throw the "weights" off quickly like the weightlifter. Instead, persevere, endure and be in control. Perseverance is the ability to stay under pressure and not give up or let go. As you carry that weight of pressure, God gives you the ability to overcome and be victorious. The pressures that you constantly face can come from the flesh-greed, pride and lust of the flesh, from the world-pressure to succumb to worldliness by being covetous and independent of God, and from the devil—temptations

Paul says in Romans 5:3-4: "And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and character, hope." God does not want you to remain a child. He wants you to grow up and be mature. He wants you to have godly character. Character does not come easily because the heart of man is sinful and rebellious. Positions and titles do not give character. It is not who you are but what you are. God allows troubles, hardship and persecutions to come, not to destroy you, but to develop your character if you persevere. Therefore, do not quickly give up under pressure. James says, "But let patience have its perfect

The Third Key: Understand the operation of hope.

and idol worship.

Unbelievers have a saying: "Cross my heart and hope to die." What a dismal picture of hope—their hope is to die! But for the Christian, "...hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us" (Romans 5:5). When your faith is tested, it is important that you do not lose your hope. "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good testimony" (Hebrews 11:1-2). Faith and hope are twins. To be a winner, you cannot have one working without the other. The foundation of your faith is the Word of God. Hope gives you the imagination to see it happen.

If you do not have hope, you will lose your faith. Satan therefore attacks you to erode your hope.

When a man's wealth is taken away, he is hindered. When his health is taken away, he is crippled. When his hope is taken away, he comes to a stop and is made inactive. When tempted in the wilderness, Jesus' strength was His hope in what God said—"It is written." You must have faith in the Word and hope in what God has promised. You must hope in faith.

The Fourth Key: Appreciate the love of God.

When you face difficulties, Satan will suggest that God does not love you. Do not allow him to succeed by doubting and questioning God. Instead, ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with His love, "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written: 'For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.' Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us" (Romans 8:35-37). Paul says, "...the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us" (Romans 5:5).

As long as you live, the pressures of the flesh, the world and the devil will challenge you. But praise God, you have the victory through Christ. Believe and rejoice! Let joy be the expression of your faith.

Rev. Dr Glen Cole, District Superintendent of the Northern California and Nevada District Council of the Assemblies of God, USA and our Senior Pastor Prince Guneratnam were the Conference Speakers.
