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Trust Requires  
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# TRUST REQUIRES TAKING A RISK

**T**o trust is to have faith in whatever you believe. Therefore, to have faith is to take a risk. Taking a risk causes fear. Someone once defined F.E.A.R. as “False Evidence Appearing Real.” Fear ultimately robs us of trusting in the Lord to have faith in living, loving, and serving God. To have faith in God is a choice.

King David said, *“But when I am afraid, I will put my trust in you. I praise God for what he has promised. I trust in God, so why should I be afraid? What can mere mortals do to me?”* (Psalm 56:3-4). Fear will inevitably confront us because we have faith and we trust God, who is omnipotent and to Him nothing is impossible.

The Book of Hebrews has many examples of ordinary individuals who decided to have faith and to trust God.

## 1. ABRAHAM HAD FAITH IN GOD FOR A CITY WITH ETERNAL FOUNDATIONS, A CITY DESIGNED AND BUILT BY GOD.

The Bible said, *“It was by faith that Abraham obeyed when God called him to leave home and go to another land that God would give him as his inheritance. He went without knowing where he was going. Abraham was confidently looking forward to a city with eternal foundations, a city designed and built by God”* (Hebrews 11:8, 10). Abraham left his home, whatever he was familiar with and his comforts to journey to a land that God would give him as his inheritance. However, God called him a friend because of his faith. The Bible said, *“And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: ‘Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith.’ He was even called the friend of God”* (James 2:23).

## 2. MOSES CHOSE BY FAITH GOD'S REWARDS INSTEAD OF WHAT THE WORLD COULD OFFER HIM.

The Bible said, *“It was by faith that Moses, when he grew up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter. He chose to share the oppression of God's people instead of enjoying the fleeting pleasures of sin. He thought it was better to suffer for the sake of Christ than to own the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking ahead to his great reward”* (Hebrews 11:24-26). The natural man does not understand the ways of God and chooses to be fearful instead of having faith. Let us choose to have faith in the promises of God, for the Bible says, *“Heaven and earth will disappear, but my words will never disappear”* (Matthew 24:35). Having faith in God and His Word will meet every challenge we may face. Jesus said, *“Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am”* (John 14:1-3).

The Bible said, *“How much more do I need to say? It would take too long to recount the stories of the faith of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel and all the prophets. By faith these people overthrew kingdoms, ruled with justice and received what God had promised them. They shut the mouths of lions, quenched the flames of fire and escaped death by the edge of the sword. Their weakness was turned to strength. They became strong in battle and put whole armies to flight”* (Hebrews 11:32-34). Similarly, let us join the heroes of faith and live a life of faith trusting God’s Word.



On the other hand, our trust in God does not always result in victory for the here and now (Hebrews 11:35b-36, 39-40). There are times God allows us to experience hardship because He wants us to trust Him. Even though the risk does not always turn out for our immediate victory, our trust in God sustains and strengthens us through hardship and difficulty. The followers of Jesus risked their lives for their faith in Jesus Christ. John the Baptist was beheaded by King Herod (Mark 6:25). Stephen was stoned to death. The Bible said, *“But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed steadily into heaven and saw the glory of God, and he saw Jesus standing in the place of honor at God’s right hand. As they stoned him, Stephen prayed, ‘Lord Jesus, receive my spirit’”* (Acts 7:55, 59). Besides that, the Apostle Peter was hanged upside down, and all the other apostles were martyred, except for one. The Apostle Paul said, *“So now I am glad to boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ can work through me. That’s why I take pleasure in my weaknesses, and in the insults, hardships, persecutions and troubles that I suffer for Christ. For when I am weak, then I am strong”* (2 Corinthians 12:9b-10).

In the same way, we can also experience God’s providence and miracles when we choose to take the risk in trusting Him. His ways are not our ways. Therefore, let us keep our eyes on God with faith and obedience because Jesus never fails! The Word of God teaches us that miracles are in our obedience.

**Y**ear 2020 has been a tough one for many. It was the honour of both sets of parents to pin the GMA onto their respective daughter's uniform,

# KEPERCAYAAN MELIBATKAN PENGAMBILAN RISIKO

**M**empercayai bererti memiliki keyakinan pada apa pun yang kamu yakini. Oleh kerana itu, beriman bererti mengambil risiko. Mengambil risiko menyebabkan ketakutan. Seseorang pernah mendefinisikan TAKUT sebagai “Bukti Palsu yang Tampak Nyata”. Rasa takut pada akhirnya merampas kepercayaan kita kepada Tuhan untuk memiliki iman dalam hidup, mengasihi dan melayani Tuhan. Beriman kepada Tuhan adalah satu pilihan.

Raja Daud berkata, “Waktu aku takut, aku ini percaya kepada-Mu; kepada Tuhan, yang firman-Nya kupuji, kepada Tuhan aku percaya, aku tidak takut. Apakah yang dapat dilakukan manusia terhadap aku?” (Mazmur 56:3-4). Rasa takut tidak dapat dielakkan akan menghadang kita kerana kita memiliki iman dan kita percaya kepada Tuhan, yang Mahakuasa dan bagiNya tidak ada yang mustahil.

Buku Ibrani memiliki banyak contoh individu biasa yang memilih untuk beriman dan percaya pada Tuhan.

## 1. ABRAHAM MEMILIKI IMAN DALAM TUHAN UNTUK SEBUAH KOTA DENGAN DASAR YANG KEKAL, SEBUAH KOTA YANG DIREKA DAN DIBINA OLEH TUHAN.

Alkitab berkata, “Karena iman Abraham taat, ketika ia dipanggil untuk berangkat ke negeri yang akan diterimanya menjadi milik pusakanya, lalu ia berangkat dengan tidak mengetahui tempat yang ia tuju. Sebab ia menanti-nantikan kota yang mempunyai dasar, yang direncanakan dan dibangun oleh Tuhan” (Ibrani 11:8, 10). Abraham meninggalkan rumahnya, apa pun yang dia kenal dan kenyamanannya untuk melakukan perjalanan ke negeri yang akan diberikan Tuhan sebagai warisannya. Namun, Tuhan memanggilnya sahabat

kerana imannya. Alkitab berkata, “Dengan jalan demikian genaplah nas yang mengatakan: “Lalu percayalah Abraham kepada Tuhan, maka Tuhan memperhitungkan hal itu kepadanya sebagai kebenaran.” Karena itu Abraham disebut: “Sahabat Tuhan.” Dia bahkan disebut sebagai sahabat Tuhan” (Yakobus 2:23).

## 2. DENGAN IMAN MUSA MEMILIH GANJARAN TUHAN DARIPADA APA YANG DUNIA DAPAT TAWARKAN KEPADANYA.

Alkitab berkata, “Karena iman maka Musa, setelah dewasa, menolak disebut anak puteri Firaun, karena ia lebih suka menderita sengsara dengan umat Tuhan dari pada untuk sementara menikmati kesenangan dari dosa. Ia menganggap penghinaan karena Kristus sebagai kekayaan yang lebih besar dari pada semua harta Mesir, sebab pandangannya ia arahkan kepada ganjaran” (Ibrani 11:24-26). Manusia semulajadi tidak memahami jalan Tuhan dan memilih untuk menjadi takut daripada memiliki iman. Marilah kita memilih untuk beriman kepada janji-janji Tuhan, kerana Alkitab berkata, “Langit dan bumi akan berlalu, tetapi perkataan-Ku tidak akan berlalu” (Matius 24:35). Memiliki iman dalam Tuhan dan FirmanNya akan memenuhi setiap cabaran yang mungkin kita hadapi. Yesus berkata, “Janganlah gelisah hatimu; percayalah kepada Tuhan, percayalah juga kepada-Ku. Di rumah Bapa-Ku banyak tempat tinggal. Jika tidak demikian, tentu Aku mengatakannya kepadamu. Sebab Aku pergi ke situ untuk menyediakan tempat bagimu. Dan apabila Aku telah pergi ke situ dan telah menyediakan tempat bagimu, Aku akan datang kembali dan membawa kamu ke tempat-Ku, supaya di tempat di mana Aku berada, kamupun berada” (Yohanes 14:1-3).



Alkitab berkata, "Dan apakah lagi yang harus aku sebut? Sebab aku akan kekurangan waktu, apabila aku hendak menceriterakan tentang Gideon, Barak, Simson, Yefta, Daud, dan Samuel dan para nabi, yang karena iman telah menaklukkan kerajaan-kerajaan, mengamalkan kebenaran, memperoleh apa yang dijanjikan, menutup mulut singa-singa, memadamkan api yang dahsyat. Mereka telah luput dari mata pedang, telah beroleh kekuatan dalam kelemahan, telah menjadi kuat dalam peperangan dan telah memukul mundur pasukan-pasukan tentara asing" (Ibrani 11:32-34). Demikian pula, marilah kita bergabung dengan para pahlawan iman dan menjalani kehidupan iman dengan mempercayai Firman Tuhan.

Di sisi lain, kepercayaan kita kepada Tuhan tidak selalu menghasilkan kemenangan di sini untuk saat ini (Ibrani 11:35b-36, 39-40). Ada kalanya Tuhan mengizinkan kita mengalami kesulitan kerana Dia ingin kita mempercayaiNya. Meskipun risikonya tidak selalu muncul untuk kemenangan bagi kita dengan serta merta, kepercayaan kita kepada Tuhan menopang dan memperkuatkan kita melalui kesulitan dan kesusahan. Para pengikut Yesus merisikokan hidup mereka kerana iman mereka dalam Yesus Kristus. Yohanes Pembaptis dipenggal kepalanya oleh Raja Herodes (Markus 6:25). Stefanus dilempari batu sampai mati. Alkitab berkata, "Tetapi Stefanus, yang penuh dengan Roh Kudus, menatap ke langit, lalu melihat kemuliaan Tuhan dan Yesus berdiri di

sebelah kanan Tuhan. Sedang mereka melemparinya Stefanus berdoa, katanya: ‘Ya Tuhan Yesus, terimalah rohku’” (Kisah Para Rasul 7:55, 59). Selain itu, Rasul Petrus digantung terbalik dan rasul-rasul lain mati syahid kecuali seorang. Rasul Paulus berkata, “Sebab itu terlebih suka aku bermegah atas kelemahanku, supaya kuasa Kristus turun menaungi aku. Karena itu aku senang dan rela di dalam kelemahan, di dalam siksaan, di dalam kesukaran, di dalam penganiayaan dan kesesakan oleh karena Kristus. Sebab jika aku lemah, maka aku kuat” (2 Korintus 12:9b-10).

Dengan cara yang sama, kita juga dapat mengalami pembekalan dan mukjizat Tuhan ketika kita memilih untuk mengambil risiko dengan mempercayaiNya. CaraNya bukanlah cara kita. Oleh kerana itu, marilah kita tetap memandang Tuhan dengan iman dan ketaatan kerana Yesus tidak pernah gagal! Firman Tuhan mengajar kita bahwa mujizat ada dalam ketaatan kita.

# 信靠须要冒险

**信**靠是对自己选择相信的一切事物有信心。因此，信靠须要冒险。冒险产生恐惧。曾经有人将恐惧定义为“真实存在的虚假证据”。恐惧最终剥夺我们对神的信靠，而在生活、爱心和服事神上对神的信心。对神有信心是一种选择。

大卫王说：“至高者啊！我惧怕的时候，就要倚靠你。靠着 神，我要赞美他的话；我倚靠 神，就必不惧怕，人能把我怎么样呢？”（诗篇 56:3-4）我们无可避免地须要面对恐惧，但是我们相信神，信靠他，他是无所不能的神，在他没有难成的事。

希伯来书中有许多平凡人选择相信和信靠神的例子。

## 1. 亚伯拉罕对神有信心，他等待那座有根基的城，就是神所设计，所建造的。

圣经上说：“因着信，亚伯拉罕在蒙召的时候，就听命往他将要承受为业的地方去；他出去的时候，还不知道要往哪里去。因为他等待那座有根基的城，就是 神所设计所建造的”（希伯来书 11:8,10）。亚伯拉罕离开他的家，他熟悉、舒适的地方，去神要赐予他为业的土地。因着他的信，神称他为朋友。圣经上说：“这正应验了经上所说的：“亚伯拉罕信 神，这就算为他的义。”他也被称为 神的朋友”（雅各书 2:23）。

## 2. 摩西凭信心选择神的赏赐，而不是世界能给他的财物。

圣经上说：“因着信，摩西长大了以后，就拒绝被称为法老女儿的儿子。他宁愿选择和 神的子民一同受苦，也不肯享受罪恶中暂时的快乐。在他看来，为着基督受的凌辱，比埃及的财物更宝贵，因为他注视将来的赏赐”（希伯来书 11:24-26）。属血气的人不了解神的方式，他们选择恐惧而不是相信神。让我们选择相信神的应许，因为圣经上说：“天地都要过去，但我的话决不会废去”（马太福音 24:35）。相信神和他的话语使我们可以面对每一个挑战。耶稣说：“你们心里不要难过，你们应当信 神，也应

当信我。在我父的家里，有许多住的地方；如果没有，我怎么会告诉你们我去是要为你们预备地方呢？我若去为你们预备地方，就必再来接你们到我那里去，好使我在哪里，你们也在哪里”（约翰福音14:1-3）。

圣经上说：“我还要再说什么呢？如果再要述说基甸、巴拉、参孙、耶弗他、大卫、撒母耳和众先知的事，时间就不够了。他们借着信，就战胜了敌国，伸张了正义，得到了应许，堵住了狮子的口，消灭了烈火的威力，逃脱了刀剑的锋刃，软弱变成刚强，在战争中显出大能，把外国的军队击退”（希伯来书 11:32-34）。让我们效仿这些信心英雄，过信靠神话语的生活。

我们信靠神，但这并不保证我们可以随时取得胜利（希伯来书 11:35b-36,39-40）。有时候神会允许我们经历困难，并信靠他。虽然我们不会总是在困境中得着胜利，但人们对神的信靠会在经历困难中扶持并坚固我们。耶稣的门徒冒着生命危险坚持他们对耶稣基督的信仰。施洗约翰被希律王斩首。（马可福音 6:25）司提反被石头打死。圣经上说：“但司提反被圣灵充满，定睛望着天，看见神的荣耀，并且看见耶稣站在神的右边。他们用石头打司提反的时候，他呼求说：‘主耶稣啊，求你接收我的灵魂！’”（使徒行传 7:55,59）使徒彼得被倒挂十字架，除了一个门徒，其他门徒都为信仰殉道了。使徒保罗说：“所以，我更喜欢夸自己的软弱，好让基督的能力临到我的身上。因此，我为基督的缘故，就以软弱、凌辱、艰难、迫害、困苦为喜乐，因为我甚么时候软弱，甚么时候就刚强了”（哥林多后书 12:9b-10）。

当我们选择冒险信靠神，就可以经历神的眷顾和神迹。神的道路非同我们的道路。让我们凭着信心和顺服把目光放在神的身上，因为耶稣永不失败！神的话语教导我们——顺服带来神迹。

Like the psalmist in Psalm 91, we must be reminded that God answers those who call out to Him. God tells us not to be fearful. With His peace in our hearts, we are able to overcome fear, even the fear of death.

In closing, Rev. Andrew exhorted all of us to continue to rely on God, just as the psalmist did.

神是信实，是公义的。诗人知道，上帝是他伸冤的神。上帝回应：他若求告我，我就应允他，搭救他，将我的救

恩显明给他。我们会遇到：危机，瘟疫，健康，生活的困难或很多的影响，我们应该选择像诗人一样，信靠上帝-祷告！要相信神的心意是：要赐福于人，要祝福人，是信实的，会实行公义，愿意帮助你。很多时候，我们认为我们可以掌握，掌握了健康。我们认为今年可以做很多的计划~目标失败了！瘟疫期间，很多人很惧怕，我们会在经济里/人的错误里，受到伤害。

上帝说不要害怕。只有透过祷告神用平安充满了你的心，才可以把惧怕拿走。祂会在旷野里开道路。信耶稣的人，才能够超越死亡的恐惧。

加略山这里有一位英文组弟兄与我分享了他的见证说：神很祝福他。他很忧虑，工作能不能维持，可能面对减薪/裁员。他出去应征了一份新工作，发现有四百多人来应征这一份工作，他感觉没有希望了。可是他得到了这份工作。他说上帝行了很大的恩典，为我预备了更好的工作。在瘟疫期间不但找到新工作，还加薪了，更靠近住家-只需30分钟车程。分享时，他的眼里充满着泪水说，好感动，上帝赐福了我。

有时候，在这瘟疫期间，我们感觉，上帝好像拿走了一些东西，我们好像失去了一些东西。但，上帝用祂自己来回报你身边的人。没有什么可让我们惧怕的，也没有什么可让我们与神的爱分开。我们的上帝是信实的，依靠祂，祂会帮助你，带领你，给你最好的祝福，长寿。盼望大家有如诗人一样(转过去祷告)，祷告就是信靠上帝。
