CHRISTMAS, GOD'S PLAN BY SENIOR PASTOR PRINCE GUNERATNAM

hristmas is God's idea. The four Gospels in the Bible teach us that Christmas was God's plan for the salvation of mankind and teaches man about the Kingdom of God. The world has commercialised the celebration of Christmas.

- God told Adam and Eve His plan. In their presence, He said to the serpent, "And I will cause hostility between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will strike [crush] your head, and you will strike his heel" (Genesis 3:15). Mary's offspring was Jesus and the serpent striking His heel referred to Jesus' crucifixion. The crucifixion is the penalty of sin Jesus paid to redeem mankind. There is coming a day when Jesus will crush the head of the serpent, who is God's arch enemy.
- 2. God spoke of His Christmas plan to bless all the peoples on earth through Abraham. God said to Abram, "Leave your native country, your relatives, and your father's family, and go to the land that I will show you. I will make you into a great nation. I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who treat you with contempt. All the families on earth will be blessed through you" (Genesis 12:1-3). Regarding the genealogy of Jesus, the Bible says, "This is the record of the ancestors of Jesus the Messiah, a descendant of David and of Abraham" (Matthew 1:1).
- God spoke of His Christmas plan to the Prophet Micah. The Prophet Micah predicted that a Saviour would be born in the city of Bethlehem. He said, "But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, are

only a small village among all the people of Judah. Yet a ruler of Israel, whose origins are in the distant past, will come from you on my behalf" (Micah 5:2). This prophecy was fulfilled when the angels announced to the shepherds, "Don't be afraid! I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people. The Saviour - yes, the Messiah, the Lord - has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David!" (Luke 2:10-11).


- 4. The Gospel of Luke in the New Testament tells us the beginning of the fulfillment of God's plan through the announcement of Jesus' birth. The Bible said, "In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee, to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David. Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, favoured woman! The Lord is with you!" Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean. "Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favour with God! You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!" Mary asked the angel, "But how can this happen? I am a virgin." The angel replied, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God" (Luke 1:26-35). Mary, a woman and a virgin, gave birth to Jesus as promised. Jesus was not born from the seed of man. Therefore, He was sinless and was worthy to forgive man of his sins.
- 5. God spoke of His Christmas plan to Joseph that Jesus would be a descendant of King David. The Bible said, "As he considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. "Joseph, son of David," the angel said, "do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife. For the child within her was conceived by the Holy Spirit. And she

will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins" (Matthew 1:20-21). It was impossible for man to pay the penalty of sin with good works. Therefore, God's provided us a Saviour who will redeem us from sin.

6. Christmas is God's idea because the Bible says, "For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). He was not willing that any of us should perish. The Bible said, "The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think. No, he is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed, but wants everyone to repent" (2 Peter 3:9).

Christmas is God's idea of Good News that will bring great joy to all people. Therefore, Christmas is to be celebrated. The Bible gives us five reasons to celebrate Christmas:

- 1. We celebrate Christmas because God sent us a Saviour and provided us the forgiveness of our sins. The angel said to Joseph, "And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." The Apostle Paul proclaimed, "Brothers, listen! We are here to proclaim that through this man Jesus there is forgiveness for your sins. Everyone who believes in him is made right in God's sight something the law of Moses could never do" (Acts 13:38-39). Through the coming of Jesus Christ, His death and resurrection, we can receive salvation by grace through faith. The Bible says, "God saved you by His grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it" (Ephesians 2:8-9). Therefore, we celebrate Christmas because of our salvation.
- 2. We celebrate Christmas because we have received eternal life. When man sinned against





God, we lost fellowship with God. However, when we put our faith in Jesus for our salvation, Jesus said, *"I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in God who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life"* (John 5:24).

3. We celebrate Christmas because God has promised to be with us. Jesus is called Immanuel. The Bible says, "Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel, which means 'God *is with us'"* (Matthew 1:23). We do not live alone because Jesus said, *"And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you"* (John 14:16). God also said, *"I will never fail you. I will never abandon you"* (Hebrews 13:5). Therefore, we celebrate Christmas because Jesus is with us in every situation.

- 4. We celebrate Christmas because God is for us. This is why the Apostle Paul declared, "So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death. What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us?" (Romans 8:1-2, 31). We celebrate Christmas joyfully because we have been made right with God and we now have fellowship with Him.
- 5. We celebrate Christmas because we do not have to fear. Through His death and resurrection, Jesus Christ has conquered death, which is man's greatest fear. The Bible records 365 "fear nots", one for each day of the year. Paul says, "And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:38-39).

The Christmas celebration is not a license, reason or excuse to compromise our faith and to sin. Instead, may this Christmas be a season of rejoicing and the sharing of the good news. Let us be His witnesses and believe God for many to be saved.

NATAL, RENCANA TUHAN

Atal adalah idea Tuhan. Empat Injil dalam Alkitab mengajar kita bahwa Natal adalah rencana Tuhan untuk menyelamatkan umat manusia dan mengajar manusia tentang Kerajaan Tuhan. Dunia telah mengkomersialkan perayaan Natal.

- Tuhan memberitahu Adam dan Hawa rencanaNya. Di hadapan mereka, Dia berkata kepada ular itu, "Aku akan mengadakan permusuhan antara engkau dan perempuan ini, antara keturunanmu dan keturunannya; keturunannya akan meremukkan kepalamu, dan engkau akan meremukkan tumitnya" (Kejadian 3:15). Anak Maria adalah Yesus dan ular yang menyerang tumitNya merujuk pada penyaliban Yesus. Penyaliban adalah hukuman atas dosa yang Yesus bayar untuk menebus umat manusia. Akan datang suatu hari ketika Yesus akan menghancurkan kepala ular, yang merupakan musuh utama Tuhan.
- 2. Tuhan berbicara tentang rencana NatalNya untuk memberkati semua orang di bumi melalui Abraham. Berfirmanlah Tuhan kepada Abram: "Pergilah dari negerimu dan dari sanak saudaramu dan dari rumah bapamu ini ke negeri yang akan Kutunjukkan kepadamu; Aku akan membuat engkau menjadi bangsa yang besar, dan memberkati engkau serta membuat namamu masyhur; dan engkau akan menjadi berkat. Aku akan memberkati orang-orang yang memberkati engkau, dan mengutuk orang-orang yang mengutuk engkau, dan olehmu semua kaum di muka bumi akan mendapat berkat. (Kejadian 12:1-3). Mengenai salasilah Yesus, Alkitab berkata, "Inilah silsilah Yesus Kristus, anak Daud, anak Abraham" (Matius 1:1).
- 3. Tuhan berbicara tentang rencana NatalNya kepada Nabi Mikha. Nabi Mikha meramalkan bahawa Juruselamat akan lahir di kota Betlehem. Dia berkata, "Tetapi engkau, hai Betlehem Efrata, hai yang terkecil di antara kaum-kaum Yehuda, dari padamu akan bangkit bagi-Ku seorang yang akan memerintah Israel, yang permulaannya sudah sejak purbakala, sejak dahulu kala" (Mikha 5:2). Nubuatan ini digenapi ketika para malaikat mengumumkan kepada para gembala, "Lalu kata malaikat itu kepada mereka: "Jangan takut, sebab sesungguhnya aku memberitakan kepadamu kesukaan besar untuk seluruh bangsa: Hari ini telah lahir bagimu Juruselamat, yaitu Kristus, Tuhan, di kota Daud" (Lukas 2:10-11).
- 4. Injil Lukas dalam Perjanjian Baru memberitahu kita permulaan dari pemenuhan rencana Tuhan melalui

pengumuman kelahiran Yesus. Alkitab berkata. "Dalam bulan yang keenam Tuhan menyuruh malaikat Gabriel pergi ke sebuah kota di Galilea bernama Nazaret, kepada seorang perawan yang bertunangan dengan seorang bernama Yusuf dari keluarga Daud; nama perawan itu Maria. Ketika malaikat itu masuk ke rumah Maria, ia berkata: "Salam, hai engkau yang dikaruniai, Tuhan menyertai engkau." Maria terkejut mendengar perkataan itu, lalu bertanya di dalam hatinya, apakah arti salam itu. Kata malaikat itu kepadanya: "Jangan takut, hai Maria, sebab engkau beroleh kasih karunia di hadapan Tuhan. Sesungguhnya engkau akan mengandung dan akan melahirkan seorang anak laki-laki dan hendaklah engkau menamai Dia Yesus. Ia akan menjadi besar dan akan disebut Anak Tuhan Yang Mahatinggi. Dan Tuhan akan mengaruniakan kepada-Nya takhta Daud, bapa leluhur-Nya, dan la akan menjadi raja atas kaum keturunan Yakub sampai selama-lamanya dan Kerajaan-Nya tidak akan berkesudahan." Kata Maria kepada malaikat itu: "Bagaimana hal itu mungkin terjadi, karena aku belum bersuami?" Jawab malaikat itu kepadanya: "Roh Kudus akan turun atasmu dan kuasa Tuhan Yang Mahatinggi akan menaungi engkau; sebab itu anak yang akan kau lahirkan itu akan disebut kudus, Anak Tuhan" (Lukas 1:26-35). Maria, seorang wanita dan seorang perawan, melahirkan Yesus seperti yang dijanjikan. Yesus tidak lahir dari benih manusia. Oleh kerana itu. Dia tidak berdosa dan lavak untuk mengampuni dosa-dosa manusia.

- 5. Tuhan berbicara tentang rencana NatalNya kepada Yusuf bahawa Yesus akan menjadi keturunan Raja Daud. Alkitab berkata. "Tetapi ketika ia mempertimbangkan maksud itu, malaikat Tuhan nampak kepadanya dalam mimpi dan berkata: "Yusuf, anak Daud, janganlah engkau takut mengambil Maria sebagai isterimu, sebab anak yang di dalam kandungannya adalah dari Roh Kudus. Ia akan melahirkan anak laki-laki dan engkau akan menamakan Dia Yesus, karena Dialah yang akan menyelamatkan umat-Nya dari dosa mereka" (Matius 1:20-21). Mustahil bagi manusia untuk membayar hukuman dosa dengan perbuatan baik. Maka. Tuhan memberi kita Juruselamat yang akan menebus kita dari dosa.
- Natal adalah idea Tuhan kerana Alkitab berkata, "Karena begitu besar kasih Tuhan akan dunia ini, sehingga la telah mengaruniakan Anak-Nya yang tunggal, supaya setiap orang yang percaya kepada-Nya tidak binasa, melainkan beroleh hidup yang kekal" (Yohanes 3:16).

Dia tidak ingin sesiapa diantara kita binasa. Alkitab berkata, "Tuhan tidak lalai menepati janji-Nya, sekalipun ada orang yang menganggapnya sebagai kelalaian, tetapi la sabar terhadap kamu, karena la menghendaki supaya jangan ada yang binasa, melainkan supaya semua orang berbalik dan bertobat" (2 Petrus 3:9).

Natal adalah idea Tuhan tentang Khabar Baik yang akan membawa sukacita besar bagi semua orang. Karena itu, Natal harus dirayakan. Alkitab memberi kita lima sebab untuk merayakan Natal:

1. Kita merayakan Natal kerana Tuhan mengutus kita seorang Juruselamat dan memberikan kita pengampunan atas dosa-dosa kita. Malaikat itu berkata kepada Yusuf, "la akan melahirkan anak laki-laki dan engkau akan menamakan Dia Yesus, karena Dialah yang akan menyelamatkan umat-Nya dari dosa mereka." Rasul Paulus menyatakan, "Jadi ketahuilah, hai saudara-saudara, oleh karena Dialah maka diberitakan kepada kamu pengampunan dosa. Dan di dalam Dialah setiap orang yang percaya memperoleh pembebasan dari segala dosa, yang tidak dapat kamu peroleh dari hukum Musa" (Kis 13:38-39). Melalui kedatangan Yesus Kristus, kematian dan kebangkitanNya, kita dapat menerima keselamatan oleh kasih karunia melalui iman. Alkitab berkata, "Sebab karena kasih karunia kamu diselamatkan oleh iman; itu bukan hasil usahamu,

tetapi pemberian Tuhan, itu bukan hasil pekerjaanmu: jangan ada orang yang memegahkan diri" (Efesus 2:8-9). Oleh kerana itu, kita merayakan Natal kerana keselamatan kita.

- 2. Kita merayakan Natal karena kita telah menerima hidup yang kekal. Ketika manusia berdosa terhadap Tuhan, kita kehilangan persekutuan dengan Tuhan. Namun, ketika kita menaruh iman kita kepada Yesus untuk keselamatan kita, Yesus berkata, "Aku berkata kepadamu: Sesungguhnya barangsiapa mendengar perkataan-Ku dan percaya kepada Dia yang mengutus Aku, ia mempunyai hidup yang kekal dan tidak turut dihukum, sebab ia sudah pindah dari dalam maut ke dalam hidup" (Yohanes 5:24).
- 3. Kita merayakan Natal kerana Tuhan telah berjanji untuk menyertai kita. Yesus disebut Imanuel. Alkitab berkata, "Sesungguhnya, anak dara itu akan mengandung dan melahirkan seorang anak laki-laki, dan mereka akan menamakan Dia Imanuel" --yang berarti: Tuhan menyertai kita" (Matius 1:23). Kita tidak hidup sendiri kerana Yesus berkata, "Aku akan minta kepada Bapa, dan la akan memberikan kepadamu seorang Penolong yang lain, supaya la menyertai kamu selamalamanya" (Yohanes 14:16). Tuhan juga berkata, "Aku sekali-kali tidak akan membiarkan engkau dan Aku sekali-kali tidak akan meninggalkan engkau" (Ibrani 13: 5).



Oleh kerana itu, kita merayakan Natal kerana Yesus menyertai kita dalam setiap situasi.

- 4. Kita merayakan Natal kerana Tuhan ada untuk kita. Inilah sebab mengapa Rasul Paulus menyatakan, "Demikianlah sekarang tidak ada penghukuman bagi mereka yang ada di dalam Kristus Yesus. Roh, yang memberi hidup telah memerdekakan kamu dalam Kristus dari hukum dosa dan hukum maut. Ia, yang tidak menyayangkan Anak-Nya sendiri, tetapi yang menyerahkan-Nya bagi kita semua, bagaimanakah mungkin la tidak mengaruniakan segala sesuatu kepada kita bersama-sama dengan Dia?" (Roma 8:1-2, 31). Kita merayakan Natal dengan sukacita kerana kita telah dijadikan benar dengan Tuhan dan kita sekarang memiliki persekutuan denganNya.
- 5. Kita merayakan Natal kerana kita tidak perlu takut. Melalui kematian dan kebangkitanNya, Yesus Kristus telah mengalahkan kematian, yang merupakan ketakutan terbesar manusia. Alkitab mencatat 365 "jangan takut", satu untuk setiap hari dalam setahun. Paulus berkata, "Sebab aku yakin, bahwa baik maut, maupun hidup, baik malaikat-malaikat, maupun pemerintah-pemerintah, baik yang ada sekarang, maupun yang akan datang, atau kuasa-kuasa, baik yang di atas, maupun yang di bawah, ataupun sesuatu makhluk lain, tidak akan dapat memisahkan kita dari kasih Tuhan, yang ada dalam Kristus Yesus, Tuhan kita" (Roma 8:38-39).

Perayaan Natal bukanlah satu lesen, sebab atau alasan untuk berkompromi dengan iman kita dan untuk berdosa. Sebaliknya, semoga Natal ini menjadi musim bersukacita dan berkongsi berita baik. Marilah kita menjadi saksiNya dan percaya kepada Tuhan agar ramai orang diselamatkan.

延是神的主意。圣经四福音书教导我们,圣诞是神 拯救人并教导神国度的计划。可是世界把圣诞给商 业化了

- 神告诉亚当和夏娃他的计划。当着他们的面,神对蛇 说:"我要使你和女人彼此为仇,你的后裔和女人的后裔, 也彼此为仇,他要伤你的头,你要伤他的脚跟"(创世记 3:15)耶稣是马利亚的后代,蛇要伤他的脚跟,是指耶稣 要被钉十字架。为了救赎人类,耶稣付上代价为罪受惩 罚,被钉在十字架上。在即将到来的那一天,耶稣要伤 蛇的头,也就是神的首号敌人。
- 神讲述他的圣诞计划,他要透过亚伯拉罕赐福给地上的 万族万民。耶和华对亚伯兰说:"你要离开本地、本族、 父家,到我指示你的地方去。我必使你成为大国,赐福 给你,使你的名为大,你也必使别人得福,给你祝 福的,我必赐福给他;咒诅你的,我必咒诅他;地上的 万族,都必因你得福"(创世记12:1-3)。关于耶稣的家 谱,圣经上说:"大卫的子孙,亚伯拉罕的后裔,耶稣基 督的家谱"(马太福音1:1)。
- 神告诉先知弥迦他的圣诞计划。先知弥迦预言将有一位 救主诞生在伯利恒。他说:"伯利恒以法他啊!你在犹大 诸城中虽然细小,必有一位从你那里出来,为我作以色 列的统治者;他的根源从太初,从亘古就有了"(弥迦书 5:2)。当天使向牧羊人宣告时,这预言就实现了。天使 说:"不要怕!看哪!我报给你们大喜的信息,是关于万 民的:今天在大卫的城里,为你们生了救主,就是主基 督"(路加福音2:10-11)。
- 4. 新约圣经路加福音告诉我们,神的计划从宣告耶稣诞生 开始。圣经上说:"到了第六个月,天使加百列奉 神差 遣,往加利利的拿撒勒城去,到了一个童贞女那里,她 已经和大卫家一个名叫约瑟的人订了婚,童贞女的名字 是马利亚。天使进去,对她说:"恭喜!蒙大恩的女子, 主与你同在!"她却因这话惊慌起来,反复思想这样祝贺 是甚么意思。天使说:"马利亚,不要怕!因你已从 神 那里蒙了恩。你将怀孕生子,要给他起名叫耶稣。他将 要被尊为大,称为至高者的儿子,主 神要把他祖大卫 的王位赐给他,他要作王统治雅各家,直到永远,他的 国没有穷尽。"马利亚对天使说:"我还没有出嫁,怎能有 这事呢?"天使回答:"圣灵要临到你,至高者的能力要覆 庇你,因此那将要出生的圣者,必称为 神的儿子"(路 加福音1:26-35)。童贞女马利亚蒙应许生了耶稣。耶稣 不是人的后裔。因此,他是无罪的,配得赦免人的罪恶。

- 5. 神跟约瑟讲述他的圣诞计划,耶稣将成为大卫王的 后裔。圣经上说:"他一直想着这些事,主的使者就在梦 中向他显现,说:'大卫的子孙约瑟,只管放胆把你的妻 子马利亚迎娶过来,因为她怀的孕是从圣灵来的。她必 生一个儿子,你要给他起名叫耶稣,因为他要把自己的 子民从罪恶中拯救出来"(马太福音1:20-21)。人不可能 透过行善免去罪的刑罚。因此,神赐给我们一位救主救 赎我们脱离罪恶。
- 圣诞是神的主意,因为圣经上说:"神爱世人,甚至把他的独生子赐给他们,叫一切信他的,不至灭亡,反得永生。"(约翰福音3:16)他不愿意我们任何人灭亡。圣经上说:"主决不耽延他的应许,像有些人以为他是耽延的一样;其实他是宽容你们,不愿有一人灭亡,却愿人人都悔改"(彼得后书3:9)。

圣诞是神的主意,是要给全人类带来喜乐的好消息。因此, 我们要庆祝圣诞。圣经告诉我们庆祝圣诞的五个原因:

- 我们庆祝圣诞因为神承诺与我们同在。耶稣也叫以 马内利。圣经上说:"必有童女怀孕生子,他的名 要叫以马内利。以马内利就是'神与我们同在'的意思"(马 太福音1:23)。我们不孤单,因为耶稣说:"我要请求 父,他就会赐给你们另一位保惠师,使他跟你们永远在 一起"(约翰福音14:16)。神也说:"我决不撇下你,也 不离弃你"(希伯来书13:5)。因此,我们庆祝圣诞是因 为无论什么情况,耶稣都与我们同在。


