

Hebrews 7-13. . .The Superiority of Christ (Level 2)**16 Jul-20 Aug ● 6 weeks**

In Hebrews 7-13, the author continues to emphasize the preeminent role of Christ in the plan of salvation, focusing particularly on the superiority of the Saviour's priesthood, His once-for-all atoning sacrifice and ministry. God has certainly provided something far better for His people in the person of Christ. Therefore, they must look only to Him, the author and perfecter of their faith and resist the temptation to give up. They must persevere in the race marked out for them, drawing inspiration from the examples of men and women who have demonstrated extraordinary faith.

Untangling Emotions Part 1 (General)**16 Jul-20 Aug ● 6 weeks**

Our emotions are complex. Some of us seem able to ignore our feelings, while others feel controlled by them. But most of us would admit that we don't always know what to do with how we feel. The tendency is to embrace positive emotions and suppress negative ones. The Bible however takes a radically different view. As counterintuitive as it seems, it is good to "feel bad" sometimes and sometimes, it is bad to "feel good"! Explore how God designed emotions for our good and learn how to properly engage your emotions and the emotions of others.

Joel. . .The Day of the Lord (Level 2)**27 Aug-17 Sept ● 4 weeks**

Devastated by a massive locust plague, the prophet Joel capitalizes on the national disaster to dispense the Lord's message of judgment on Judah. He calls the people to repentance and warns them of the coming of the "great and dreadful day of the Lord." The warning of impending judgement is followed by the promise of restoration and the outpouring of God's Spirit upon all people such as never experienced before under the Law. As it was back then, the prophetic message of Joel is a reminder to us to live wisely in the light of the Lord's soon coming.

Choose Joy: Because Happiness is not Enough (General)**27 Aug-17 Sept ● 4 weeks**

The day she lost her son to suicide, Kay Warren's life changed forever. We may not face such devastating tragedy but daily, we are confronted with challenging situations that threaten to steal our joy. Based on the inspiring book, *Choose Joy* written by Kay (wife of pastor and best-selling author Rick Warren), this course seeks to help you understand life-giving truths that will strengthen your convictions about God so that He becomes the source of your strength when happiness isn't enough. The good news is true joy is possible even for those who live with the constant companions of discouragement and depression.
