The heart of the problem in the church at Corinth was that they were conforming to the world rather than influencing the world. The church was fractured, and the chief reason was pride. This pride manifested itself in a skewed view of the gospel, which led to sinful attitudes, disorderly worship, lawsuits, misuse of Christian freedom and spiritual gifts. Paul admonishes believers to return to the heart of the gospel and replace pride with Christ-centred love and unity, living as godly examples amidst the moral decadence of the day.

Despite constant waves of persecution, the Early Church continued to thrive, living within the structures of a society empowered by the love of Christ. A new generation of leaders succeeds the apostles – the early church fathers, most of whom were disciples of the apostles. During this period (100 – 312 A.D.), the church was confronted with a war on two fronts. While battling to preserve its existence in the face of attempts by the Roman state to abolish it, heresies posed major dangers from within. Apologists and Christian thinkers emerged to combat false teachings and controversies that eventually led to the establishment of the New Testament canon.
