The Prodigal Prophet: Jonah and the Mystery of God's Mercy (General)

8 July – 5 Aug (5 weeks)

A rebellious, runaway prophet who defies God and is swallowed by a whale. Most of us are familiar with the story of Jonah but there's much more to it than we realize. Of all the prophets, Jonah is perhaps the most reluctant and yet there are unmistakably clear connections between Jonah, the prodigal son, and Jesus. Jesus in fact saw Himself in Jonah. How could that be? Discover the powerful message at the heart of Jonah's story and what it means for us as followers of Christ today.

Freedom from Fear

8 July – 29 July (4 weeks)

In today's world, fear has become epidemic. We grapple with inhibiting fears such as fear of pandemic, fear of loss, fear of suffering, fear of death and fear of the future. Fear cripples us, takes over our mind and plunges our thoughts into darkness. It is easy to feel helpless, but we don't have to remain a prisoner of fear, anxiety or stress. Learn how you can conquer your fears. Discover the distinction between the fear God does not want us to have, the fear God allows us to have, and the fear God wants us to have.

My Faith (General) | 5 July – 9 Aug (6 weeks)

My Faith provides believers with an understanding of the "Statement of Fundamental Truths" that contains the tenets of faith that Calvary Church as an Assembly of God church adheres to. These fundamental doctrines provide the biblical basis for the practices and beliefs of our Christian faith which are essential building blocks to help you establish a firm foundation in Christ as well as strengthen your commitment to the Church and its mission to fulfil the Great Commission given by our Lord Jesus Christ. This course is a prerequisite for all seeking membership with Calvary Church.

The Theology Series. . .God's Great Plan of Salvation (Level 2) | 12 July – 9 Aug (5 weeks)

Salvation is both an act of God and a personal experience. As an act of God, the term salvation describes what God has done for us through Jesus Christ. As an experience, it refers to the application of this salvation to us through the Holy Spirit. But what are we saved from? What is the proof of the sufficiency of Christ's sacrifice for our salvation? This course seeks to explore the different theories of atonement, Christ's resurrection and its implication as well as the beginning, continuation and completion of God's salvific work in our lives.

God's Peace amid Chronic Illness and Disability (General) | 12 July – 9 Aug (5 weeks)

Why is this happening to me? Is God punishing me? Has my sin brought on this condition? If I have enough faith, will God heal me? How can my life have purpose when I am battling a debilitating illness? Like any loss, the loss of health—must be grieved. Covering everything from anger and fear to loneliness and hopelessness, this course seeks to address the common feelings felt by those with a chronic illness or impairment and above all, to offer hope and a biblical prescription for victorious living.

Mandarin Class: Lord Teach Us to Pray: The Lord's Prayer | 5 July – 9 Aug (6 weeks)

God is a willing listener, inviting us to pray and receive His blessings as we offer up our petitions and thanksgiving to Him. In teaching us how to pray in Matthew 6:9-13, Jesus emphasizes our relationship with our Heavenly Father and His desire for us to focus on His will and plan. He reminds us of God's providence and our need for forgiveness while recognizing our moral responsibility to resist temptation as we look to Him to deliver us from the evil one. Come learn how to pray so you can stay strong through the trials and temptations of life.

Cantonese Class: The Fruit of the Spirit 5 July – 9 Aug (6 weeks)

Since God's goal is for us to be like Jesus, the Holy Spirit constantly works to rid our lives of the "acts of the sinful nature" and display His fruit instead. The presence of the "fruit of the Spirit" is evidence that our character is becoming more like Christ's. The Apostle Paul uses nine characteristics to describe the fruit of the Spirit in the book of Galatians. Come and experience what the Holy Spirit can do in and through you as you give the Holy Spirit control of your life and shape you to be more like Jesus.
