| Level 2 | For those who have been believers for more than 3 years, have a good understanding of the Word and are seeking to be equipped for service and church ministry involvement. |

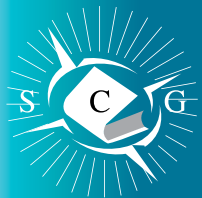

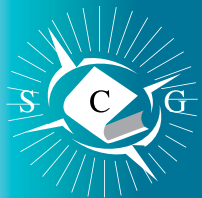

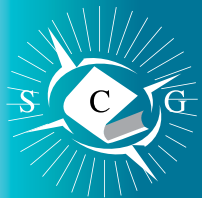

Colossians: Fullness of Life in Christ

(Level 2)



Fullness and freedom are two aspects of the Christian life that we strive towards. In his letter to the believers in Colossae, Paul addressed false teachings that suggested “mere Christianity” was not enough — that greater experiences and deeper liberation could be found elsewhere. Paul counters by declaring that all the fullness of God is found in Christ alone, and only through His finished work are we made complete. He reminds this young church, facing cultural pressure and confusion, that Christ is above all, holds all things together, and is sufficient for every need. As we journey through Colossians, we learn to root our identity in Christ, grow in maturity, and reflect His lordship in every area of life.

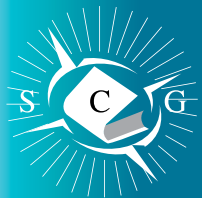

Mandarin Class: Living Out the Fullness of Psalm 23

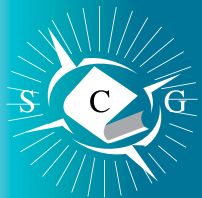
